Dear Mammoth Lakes Voter:

As you may have heard, a mistake was made on both the sample ballot which you recently received and the actual ballots for the June 7 Primary Election. There are two seats up for election for the Mammoth Lakes Town Council, and the ballots mistakenly instruct you to vote for three candidates. This mistake was mine, and I apologize for the confusion and inconvenience this is causing.

Because of this error, we will be issuing a replacement ballot for just the Town Council contest, and will not be counting the Town Council results on the ballot containing the mistake. This solution was developed with input from the Town Council and attorneys for both the Town and the County. If you vote at the precinct (all precincts will be voting at the Mammoth High School library for this election), you will be given two ballots when you check in. Further instruction will be provided at the precinct and poll workers will be present to answer questions and provide guidance. If you vote by mail, the new ballot will be mailed to you prior to the May 31 mailing deadline and will contain detailed instructions. Your return envelope will already have the postage paid. Please make sure that the ballot is postmarked on or before June 7.
