- Mammoth Lakes, Inyo County and Nevada residents are welcome to take advantage of the low cost vaccination clinics but are reminded that they need to purchase dog licenses in their own jurisdiction.
- Rabies vaccinations: \$10.00.
 Canine and feline vaccinations/boosters will also be available.
 Dogs must have a current rabies vaccination prior to licensing for 2020/2021.
- For the protection of your cat, other cats, family and the community, we strongly urge that all cats be given rabies vaccinations as well any other feline vaccinations needed for their health and protection.
- To expedite waiting time, please bring last year's license receipt. If corrections need to be made to your dog license application form, please advise staff at the time of licensing.

Safety Considerations:

- <u>If you have a dog that may be aggressive</u> towards humans or other dogs, or hard to handle, please leave him/her in your vehicle until all paperwork is completed. The attending Veterinarian will go to your vehicle to administer vaccinations.
- Please secure your dog on a leash while waiting to be served.
- Prior to standing in line for service, we ask that you <u>secure</u> your cat inside a carrier.
 Animal Control staff can provide a cat carrier upon request.

Licensing Laws:

<u>Title 17 –Ca. Code of Regulations 2696.04©</u> Officially Declared Rabies Areas. "States that any agency with a fixed one year licensing program cannot license a dog if the <u>three year rabies vaccination expires before the expiration of the 2019/2020 license".</u>

If your dogs' rabies vaccination falls in this category, please have your dog re-vaccinated at a low cost vaccination clinic or with your family veterinarian prior to licensing.

<u>Health and Safety Code 1920 (b), Mono County Code 9.20.010</u> – <u>All</u> dogs over the age of 4 months shall be vaccinated for rabies at prescribed intervals.

<u>Health and Safety Code 1920 (a), Mono County Code 9.12.060</u> - All dogs over the age of 4 months shall have and wear a current Mono County dog license.
