

“Antelope Valley Regional Planning Advisory Committee Minutes 01-04-2018”
SP3 RPAC S17-01

Members Present: Katy Buell, Chair, Orval Mosby, Dan Anthony, Don Morris, Patti Christensen, Mark Langner, Bruce Woodworth.

Agency/Public present: Supervisor John Peters, Gerry Le Francois, County Planner, Sgt. Major Doug Powers, Marine liaison, Eric Edgerton, Pam Hamic & Chuck.

Approved minutes (motion Christensen/2nd Mosby) unanimously but with Anthony abstaining.

Christensen - Hospice Group meeting before the RPAC meeting. Volunteer non-medical is the model. They will soon meet with a prototype group, a 501c3. Proposed group to include Lee Vining. Noted: Firefighters of the year – Jason Foster & Andy White.

Mosby – reported an anecdotal caution on cannabis from another county: smell is difficult problem, some new employees from outside the area associated with robbery and arson. Spoke in favor of the peacefulness of AV.

Sgt. Major: Upcoming intense Marine activities; asked for more snow.

John Peters. Eric Dillingham is acting Forest Ranger. Senior Center: Pat Espinosa has done wonders with a serious shortage of assistants. Exterior lights for Community Center likely to be installed in about two months. SB1 road funds incoming. Canyon paving next summer. BOS Legislative Platform on website including hospice & trails. Recreation Position money is in budget in conjunction with Town (3/5 cost). SB5 for water and trails monies. Cannabis – town and county have moratoriums for now; June or Nov. cannabis-related taxes to be sought. Peters described the many committee assignments that supervisors have. Upcoming Town Hall meeting will address Community Campus and roads.

Community Campus. Joe Blanchard & Gerry Le Francois will meet next week to discuss. Christensen to join in the meeting.

Election. Mike Curti, Chair, Patti Christensen, Vice Chair, Langner and Woodworth as joint secretaries. Office elections unanimous approved. Edgerton application for the RPAC is in process.

Upcoming: Baker & Associates hazard mitigation plan; Scenic Byway project (there are only three County planners with Scott Burns' retirement) so a consultant is working on it; Dark Sky, Mt. Gate Cleanup dates in April or May rather than July.

Anthony: Concern with cannabis lighting. Le François: Discretionary approval of cannabis allows lighting regulation.
