Public: One Zoom participant.

Public Comments: Debie said that there will be craft vendors in the park this weekend and that a star party will be held at the Walker ball field on July 19th. Mark and Debie commented on the proposed 30% Liberty Energy rate increase; people can submit comments at the California PUC website.

The minutes from the May 1, 2025 were approved (6 yes, 1 abstention).

Info/discussion items:

RPAC member reports: Bruce spoke about the recent successful Mt Gate Park clean-up. Mark asked if it was known when CalTrans would start the Walker striping project and Wendy said that she would check; the design is in the 11/24 RPAC packet.

MWTC update: None presented but Wendy said that she recently had a discussion with MWTC representatives and that a change to quarterly RPAC updates is being considered.

USFS update: none presented.

Supervisor's Report: none presented.

Planning Update: Wendy said that a proposal for a private campground on 108 near the pack station will be handled as a director's review and LDTAC will review.

Next meeting: The group felt that the July RPAC meeting could be cancelled if there are no timely or important issues to be examined or discussed.
