

MONO COUNTY ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD OPENINGS!

The County of Mono is accepting applications to fill five Board Member vacancies on the Assessment Appeals Board (AAB).

The AAB is a quasijudicial body which hears taxpayer appeals to property assessments at a public hearing where evidence is submitted by both parties, the taxpayer and the Assessor's Office. The AAB hearing process provides 'equalization', or fairness of the assessment of a property's value of the property in question.



Eligibility

Individuals interested in applying must meet the following requirements: A minimum of five years' professional experience within the state of California is required in one of the following professions:

- Certified Public Accountant or Public Accountant
- Licensed Real Estate Broker
- Attorney
- Property Appraiser Certified by 1) a Nationally Recognized Professional Organization; 2) the Office of Real Estate Appraisers; or 3) the California State Board of Equalization.

TRAINING WILL BE PROVIDED!

Compensation

Board Members receive a taxable stipend for their attendance as follows:

- \$175 per meeting (typically 8-10 meetings per year, typically 2-4 hours in duration)
- Mileage reimbursement (current IRS standard mileage rate) for travel from the Board Member's residence to the hearing location.
