RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF MONO IN APPRECIATION OF THE ANTELOPE VALLEY COMMUNITY CENTER VOLUNTEERS WHEREAS, Volunteers from the Antelope Valley came together and built the very first Community Center in Walker; and WHEREAS, the Antelope Valley communities came together once again to enlarge the community center a second time: and WHEREAS, in 2005 the Board of Supervisors heard the voices of the Antelope Valley and understanding the need for yet a larger community center, supported the idea by allocating funds for an addition; and WHEREAS, and while the project seemed to hit road block after road block, Dave "Pit Bull" Murray never gave up; and WHEREAS, after 8 1/2 years, Dave "Pit Bull" Murray, along with other volunteers and County Staff, finally put boots on the ground, a crow bar in one hand and a hammer in the other; and WHEREAS, over 20 volunteers donated over 2500 hours of labor, many times doing the "grunt" work, worked vigorously to see the latest addition move forward towards completion; and WHEREAS, several of the area's "Women's Organizations" members banded together to help feed the group of volunteers on a daily basis; and WHEREAS, Lynn Scherer, while diligently working away, looked away for a just moment and almost paid the "Ultimate Sacrifice" (we'll leave that story for another time); and WHEREAS, many volunteers without any construction knowledge, stepped up and did whatever was asked of them; and Now, Therefore it be resolved, the Mono County Board of Supervisors hereby extend a most sincere "THANK YOU" in appreciation for the hard work, the dedication and enthusiasm that these volunteers have shown in the construction of the third addition to the Antelope Valley Community Center in the town of Walker; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, all of the named volunteers are hereby extended Mono County's sincerest gratitude for weeks of outstanding volunteerism to their community of Antelope Valley.
