Report on Recycling Plan at Outlying county facilities:

Based on Board comments during Baxter contract, want to report on the effort to expand recycling at all County facilities.

The expansion of recycling into these facilities has been planned but implementation has been on hold, pending completion of other recycling efforts (wood chip/boiler, paper at TS) but it is the next logical expansion of County recycling efforts. Funding was identified in 16/17 budget, so staff is ready to go ahead with the following effort:

1. Purchase outdoor receptacles at the following locations:

Walker Park (2)
Mtn Gate Park (2)
Bridgeport Courthouse (2)
Bridgeport Park (2)
Bridgeport Ball Field (1)
Bridgeport Marina (1)
June Lake Ball Field (1) may require bear-proof Lundy Campground (2)
Chalfant Park (1)
Benton Park (1)

### **Outdoor Receptacles:**





Similar to Courthouse

Similar to existing trash receptacles

(None of these locations have experienced bear problems that would justify bear-proof recycling containers at this time, except JL Ball Field905)

The cost of the outdoor receptacles is approximately \$500 each, totaling \$7,500. If bear problems arise, the cost of a bear-proof container will be approximately \$1,100 each.

2. In addition, staff would recommend the purchase of indoor receptacles (1 large or 2 small) for use at the following community centers, to allow people who rent the community center to facilitate recycling at their event:

Walker community center Bridgeport Memorial Hall

## **Chalfant Community Center Benton Community Center**

### Indoor Receptacles:



The cost of these (one large or two small) receptacles is approximately \$150 for each site, for a total of \$600

Recycling services are already provided at all other County Community Centers and Parks by Sierra Conservation Project.

Most of the above facilities will be serviced by Don Baxter, at a cost of \$13 per month, per facility, with an annual total of \$1400 per year.

The remainder of the locations will be serviced by our janitorial staff during normal rounds of the facilities.

All beverage containers recycled through this program will be delivered by Don Baxter to the Walker Recycling Center.
