Sups Budget Meeting 8-13

I am Don Morton, June Lake business owner and a Commissioner on the Mono Co Fish Commission. I am speaking as a concerned fisherman, not on behalf of Fish Commission.

- Every year we have the same "the sky is falling" discussion about spending \$100,000 on stocking mutant, sterile trout.
- At the same time, no money is committed towards changing the future of fishing in Mono County.

I would like to encourage the Board of Supervisors to:

- Restrict the amount of funds spent on stocked fish to what is approved in the budget meetings
- Require a % of funds be dedicated to enhancing the future of fishing in Mono County.
- Emergency request DF&W to reduce limits from 5 to 2 fish daily. I would recommend it be done permanently.

The old defenses of fish stocking no longer apply

- Fishing IS NOT the backbone of the general economy of Mono County.
- Tourism has been exploding, while at the same time, our fisheries continue a decades long decline.
- The sport is called fishing, NOT catching. We cannot compete with the likes of Santa Ana River Lakes.
- The Supervisors should look to the future and explore funding alternatives to stocking mutant sterile trout
- There are alternatives!
- We must find them.
- Or, just record this budget discussion and replay again next year.

Possible change to the future of stocking trout in Mono County

Objective:

- 1. Replace stocking triploid rainbows with stocked LCTs
- 2. Identify Grant sources
- 3. Identify strains that can be used
- 4. Identify hatchery
- 5. Hire consultant as required to explore and identify issues

Replace stocking triploid rainbows with diploid LCT

- Begin with North Mono County as it is a native fish
- Stock no other trout in waters above Conway summit

Identify Grant sources

- Search out grants available for restoring LCT's to native water
- Identify how to secure services of Grant writer and pay for the service
- Identify other potential interested participants

Identify Strain that can be used

- Consult with California, Nevada, and Federal agencies to locate acceptable stain
- Secure source for brood stock

Hatchery

- Identify potential suitable hatchery locations
- Explore possible leasing of CDF&W hatchery
