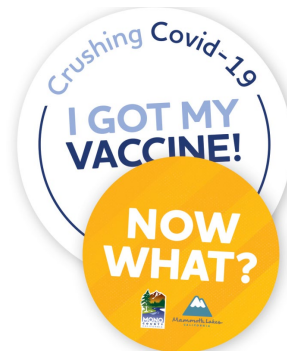




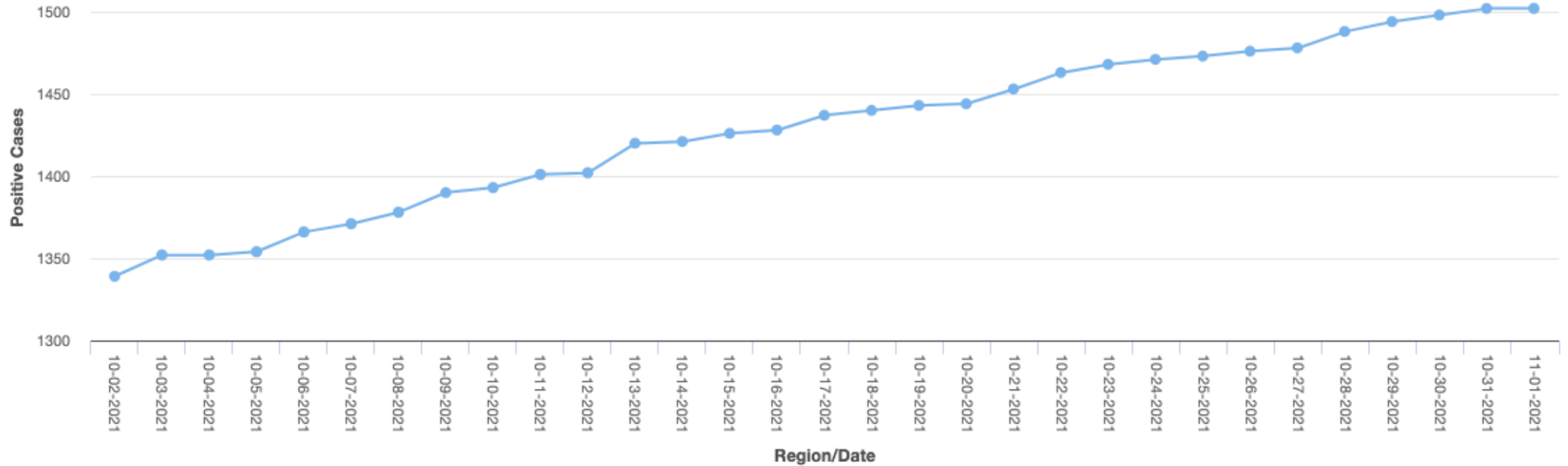

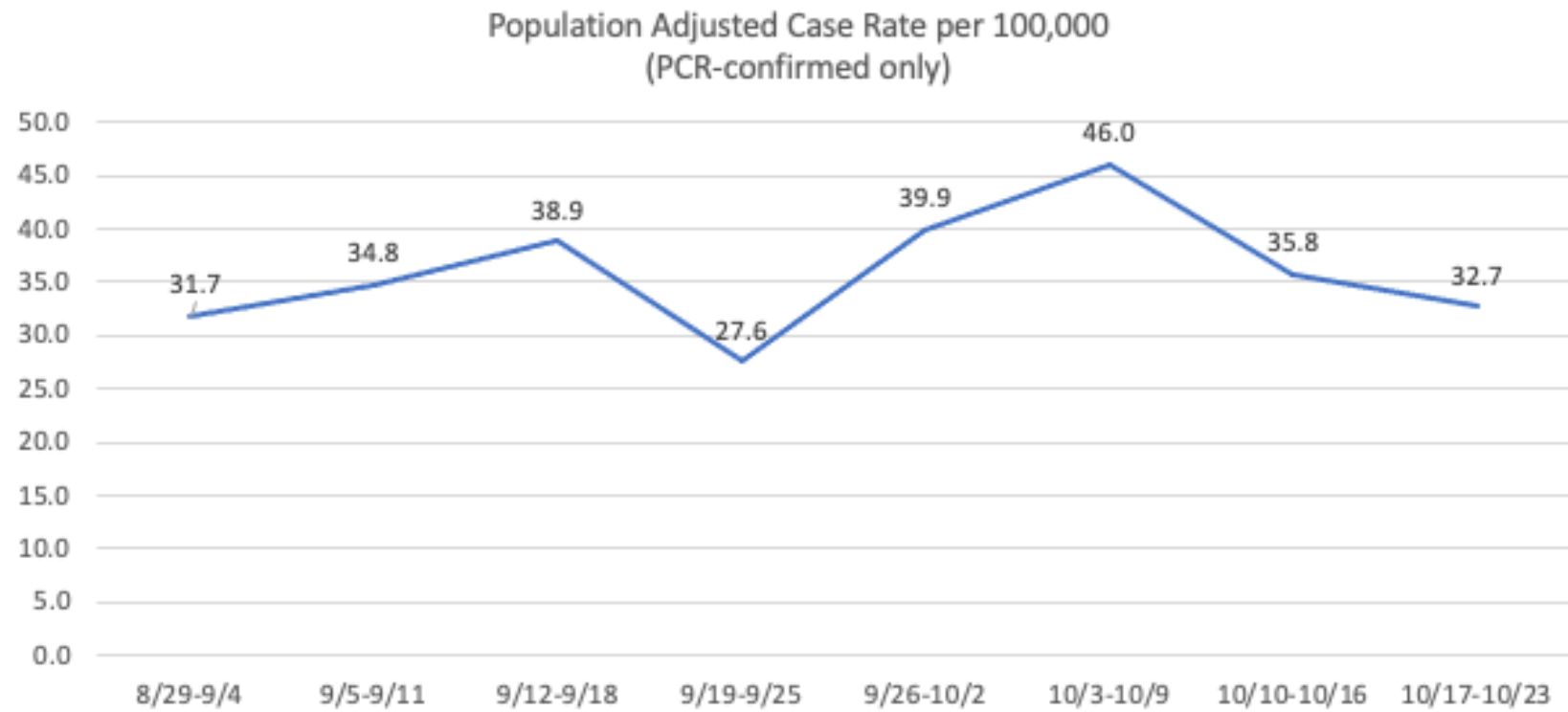


Total Positive Cases for Mono County Residents (last 30 d...

CDPH REGIONAL UPDATES

There are three main metrics we watch when trying to assess potential new surge:

1. R-effective
2. Case rate
3. Test positivity

Typically, the three metrics align – no single metric is a better indicator.

Areas of current concern:

- Greater Sacramento area showing increase in R-effective
- RANCHO (Mono County) & San Joaquin Valley showing concerning high case rate and test positivity

**RECENT DEATH
OF A MONO
COUNTY
RESIDENT**

- Resident of unincorporated Mono County
- Tested positive/passed at a facility in Southern California
- We were notified last week, death occurred approximately one month ago
- Per our records, patient was unvaccinated and elderly

PFIZER VACCINES FOR 5 TO 11 YEAR OLD CHILDREN

- Pfizer COVID 19 vaccine was granted FDA approval for 5 to 11 year old children. CDC meeting today to vote on the EUA for this age group.
- Public Health will offer school based clinics to help reach this age group.
- Concerned parents should talk to their pediatricians if they have questions or concerns.

COVID VACCINE STATEWIDE SCHOOL MANDATE

- California Becomes First State in Nation to Announce COVID-19 Vaccine Requirements for Schools:
 - *After implementing first-in-the-nation school masking and staff vaccination measures, California becomes the first state to announce plans to require student vaccinations – adding the COVID-19 vaccine to list of vaccinations required for school, such as the vaccines for measles, mumps, and rubella.*
 - *Students will be required to be vaccinated for in person learning starting the term following FDA full approval of the vaccine for their grade span (7-12 and K-6).*
 - *Vaccinations for 5 – 11-year-old expected to have EUA between Halloween and Thanksgiving.*

COVID VACCINE LOCAL SCHOOL MANDATE

- On October 28th, the Mammoth Unified School District (MUSD) Board voted 3-2 to mandate COVID-19 vaccines for students as each age range receives full FDA approval.

BOOSTERS FOR THE GENERAL POPULATION

- COVID-19 Vaccine booster shots are available for the following Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderns, and J&J vaccine recipients who completed their initial series at least 6 months ago or 2 months for J&J:
 - 65 years and older
 - 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
 - 18+ who work in high-risk settings
 - 18+ who live in high-risk settings

MIX AND MATCH VACCINE APPROVED

- Data indicates mixing and matching of all COVID 19 is safe and effective
