

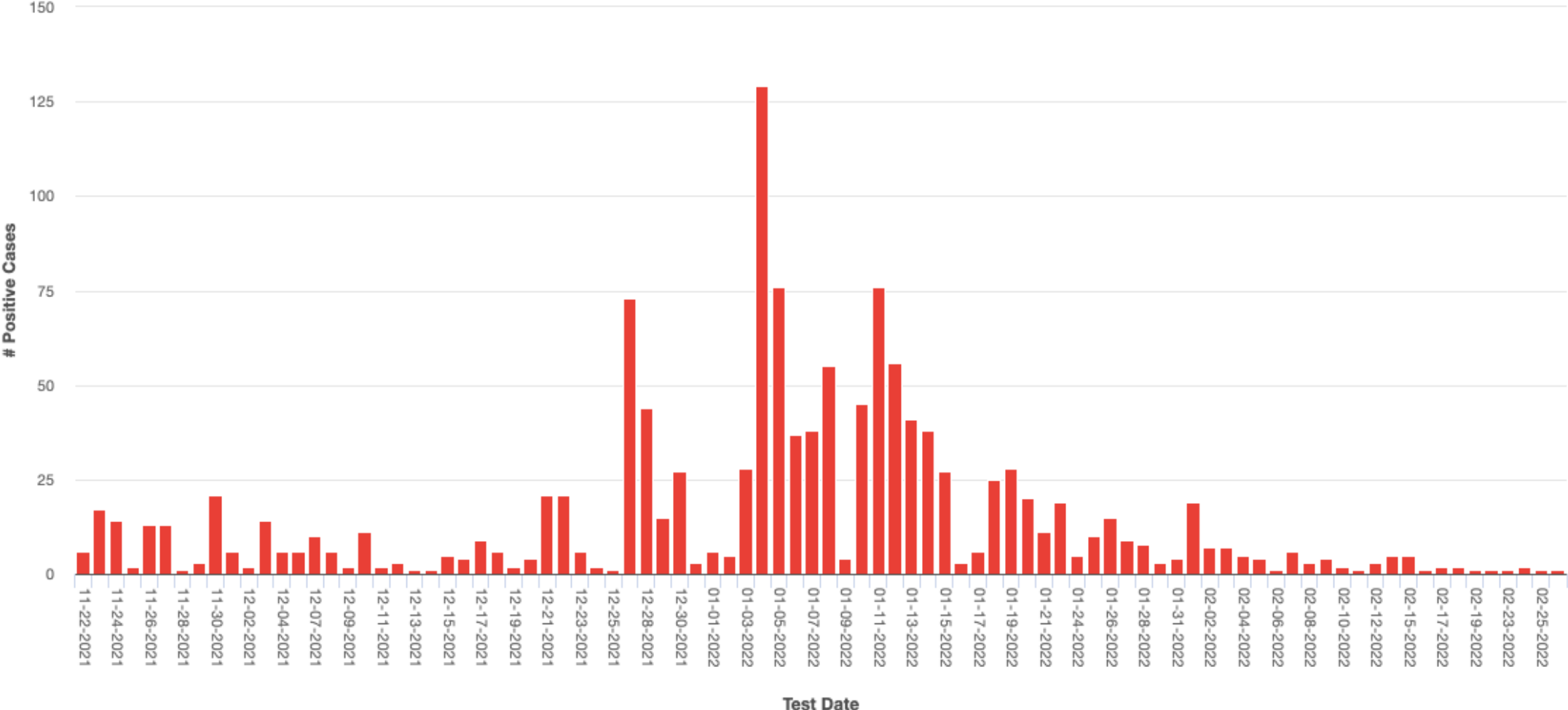

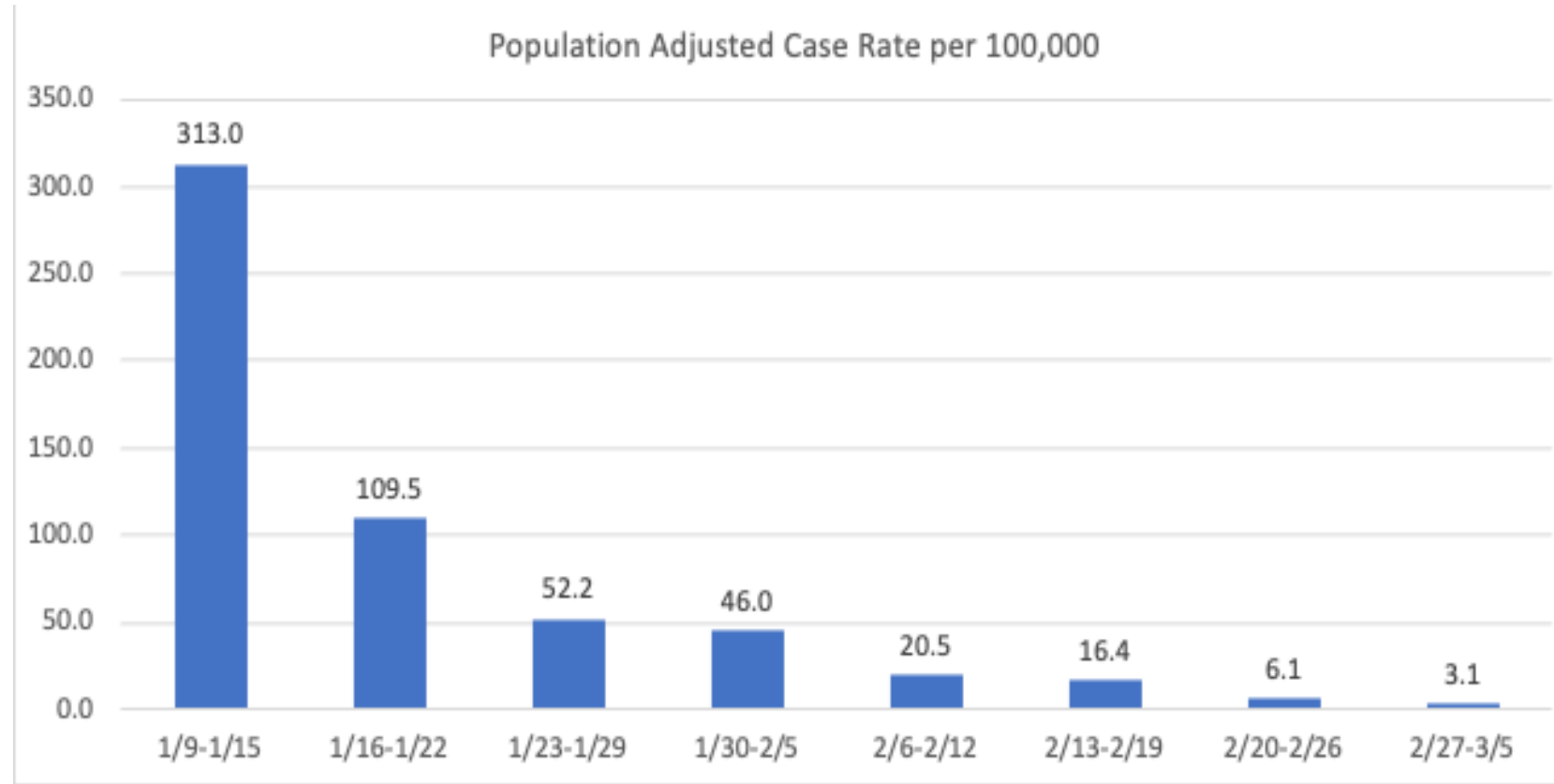


Positive Lab Confirmed Results by Day for the Past 60 Days (Public)

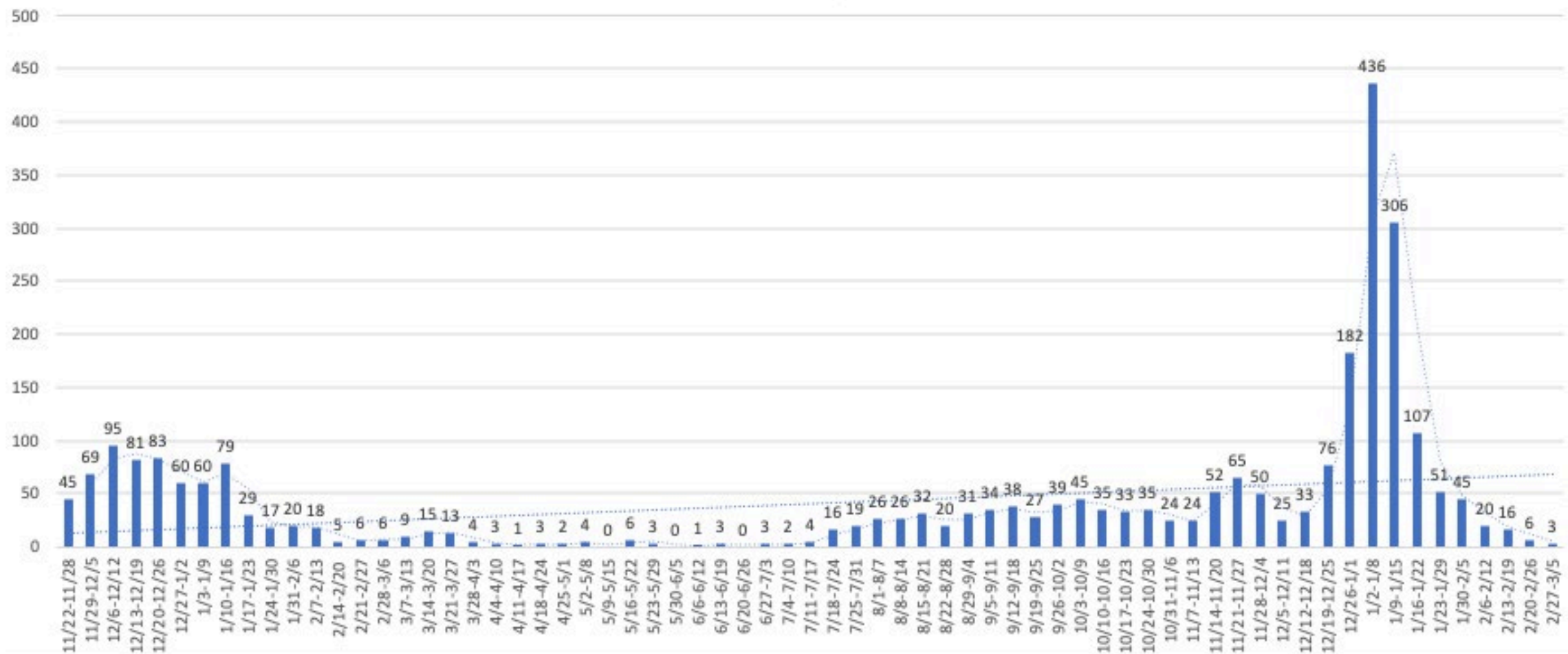


TOTAL POSITIVE CASES (PCR CONF): 2963 POSITIVITY RATE: 8.2% / CASE RATE/100,000: 3.1

OMICRON BA.2

- The Omicron variant spreads more easily than the original SARS-CoV-2 strain of the virus that causes COVID-19, and previous variants, including Delta.
- According to Danish scientists, the Omicron subvariant BA.2, is 1 ½ times more transmissible than the original Omicron strain.
- While there is currently no evidence that the BA.2 lineage is more severe than the BA.1 lineage, experts have warned that BA.2 could extend the current wave of COVID-19 infections in the U.S.
