Mono County Board of Supervisors Actions

September 2, 2025 Meeting Highlights:

- The Board adopted a Proclamation designating the month of September 2025 as Suicide Prevention Month.
- The Board adopted a Proclamation designating the month of September 2025 as National Preparedness Month.
- The Board adopted a Proclamation celebrating California's 175th Anniversary of Statehood.
- Correspondence Sent - The Board approved sending a letter of opposition to the California Public Utilities Commission regarding Southern California Edison (SCE) General Rate Case.
- The Board received a presentation regarding Wildfire Preparedness by the Town of Mammoth Lakes.
- The Board received an update on the County's Jail project followed by a groundbreaking event.

August 19, 2025 Meeting Highlights:

- The Board authorized the Office of Emergency Management to submit the Cal Fire Wildfire Prevention Grant application.
- The Board was presented with the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year Budget Hearing. Staff suggested that the Board consider the FY 2025-26 recommended budget and provide staff direction on the policy items to include in the adopted budget, funding commitments, and increasing the balance of the General Reserve fund using Liberty Litigation funds.
