##### January 13, 2026 Meeting Highlights

- **Election of New 2026 Board Chair, Vice Chair, and Chair Pro-Tem:** The Board elected Supervisor Jennifer Kreitz (District 1) as Chair, Supervisor, Paul McFarland (District 3) as Vice-Chair, and Supervisor Rhonda Duggan (District 2) as Chair Pro-Tem.
