- a. **Unmet Transit Needs: Olya Egorov** - Presentation given - Transit is going North to Reno and South to Lone Pine 7 days a week now - always seeking input for needs in the communities - Request made to add an additional pickup stop in Bridgeport at the site of the new jail - Request made to continue looking into possible addition of pickup location at Sonora Junction and 395.

- d. MCMWTC Letter from AVRPAC: CDD Staff - the Antelope Valley RPAC has written a letter to base command recognizing the importance of having someone from the base attend the RPAC meetings - Brianna will write a letter to go in front of the RPAC at the next meeting;

RPAC member reports/comments** - Nick - Fire Dept is fully staffed - calls are beginning to pick up - Fire Department received a grant to purchase a new type 1 engine as well as beginning a drone program; Jeff Hunewill - spring is coming early with lots of activities happening - summer is looking good with reservations at the ranch; Steve - 2026 projections for business are looking better than 2025 - the cable for the banner across main street broke and the banner came down they are looking at getting that repaired - CSA is looking into helping with funding for the new bathroom at the park; Brianna - 4th of July Dinner happening this weekend; Jimmy - there was 2 winter sky events this year and both were a success - August 8th will be Bodie Days - MCOE is looking for representatives to sit on the Mono Co Child Care Counsel;

Economic Development update - Liz Grans - Mono County residents can participate in a tri-counties economic recreation planning impact study - the study will be open online until April 30th - Fish stocking will be happening again with a mix of trophy size and planter size - Mono County will be setting up Golden Mussel inspection stations in communities for boats to be allowed to enter our water ways;

Public Works director is retiring - there are personnel changes in the finance department - Patricia Robertson is the new housing coordinator - the county has approved a contract to bring in a consultant to do an analysis of the EMS dept and then will be flying for the position - the assessment appeals board is looking for volunteers;
