NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mono County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on August 9, 2022, at 9:00 am in the Mono County Courthouse at 278 Main St., Bridgeport, California, with a videoconference site available at the Mono County Civic Center at 1290 Tavern Road, Mammoth Lakes, California, in order to discuss a possible application for funding under the next fiscal year's (July 1 to June 30) State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program to support Project Homekey and receive public input on any other potential projects to be included. Under Project Homekey, an existing hotel in Mammoth Lakes will be converted to 15 apartments for the local homeless population at various income levels below 80% AMI. There will be one manager's unit. The site is near free local transit, a job center, shopping, and childcare. CDBG funds are proposed to be utilized for the planning and design aspects of this rehabilitation project. The purpose of this public hearing is to give the public an opportunity to comment on the proposed application and provide input on any other types of eligible activities Mono County should apply for under the State CDBG program.
