Mono County Supervisor John Peters Elected Western Interstate Region 2nd Vice President

Organization Advocates on Public Policy Issues Impacting the Western States

MONO COUNTY, Calif. (MAY 26, 2023) – Mono County Supervisor John Peters (District 4) was elected 2nd Vice President of the National Association of Counties (NACo) Western Interstate Region (WIR) Board of Directors during their annual conference in Washington County, Utah earlier this month. WIR is dedicated to the promotion of western interests within NACo, including public land issues, community stability and economic development, and the promotion of the traditional western way of life.

"I am grateful for the opportunity to serve in this leadership capacity, which will help to elevate advocacy efforts on behalf of Mono County and our fellow western state counties," said Supervisor Peters.
