**Emergency Alert Test Scheduled for Monday, October 7th**

*Subscribe to READY Mono to Receive Emergency Alerts*

**MONO COUNTY, Calif. (September 26, 2024)** – The Mono County Office of Emergency Management will be conducting a test of the emergency alert system on Monday, October 7<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. These alerts are essential in notifying Mono County residents and visitors during emergency events related to weather, natural disasters, and public health crises. Mono County utilizes a cloud-based, public alerting and residential safety tool that allows the Office of Emergency Management to send geo-targeted urgent alerts to subscribers. Residents and visitors are encouraged to visit [READY Mono](#) to subscribe to the emergency alert system in advance of the test on October 7<sup>th</sup>.
