ABOUT THE VIDEO:

The Camp Like a Pro video, "Campfire Safety," introduces visitors to the best practices for having a safe and responsible campfire in the Eastern Sierra. This lighthearted, PSA-style video walks viewers through how to get a campfire permit, check for fire restrictions, properly extinguish a fire, and consider safer alternatives to rock fire rings.

With wildfire risk increasing each year in the Eastern Sierra due to prolonged drought, high winds, and dry vegetation, it's more important than ever for visitors to understand how their actions can prevent human-caused wildfires. When not properly managed, campfires can pose a serious risk of ignition. That's why this message is essential to sustaining the landscapes we all love.

Funded by Whitebark Institute, Mammoth Lakes Tourism, and Mono County, "Campfire Safety" is the third video in the Camp Like a Pro series, which helps visitors learn how to recreate responsibly in the Eastern Sierra. The first two videos in the series cover "Dispersed Campsite Selection" and "How to Poo Like a Pro in the Eastern Sierra."
