Mono County Board of Supervisors Announces 2026 Leadership Appointments

Supervisor Jennifer Kreitz Elected Chair; Board Recognizes Outgoing Leadership

BRIDGEPORT, CA (January 14, 2026) — During its January 13 meeting, the Mono County Board of Supervisors took formal action to elect its leadership for the 2026 calendar year. The Board is pleased to announce the election of Supervisor Jennifer Kreitz (District 1) as Chair, Supervisor Paul McFarland (District 3) as Vice-Chair, and Supervisor Rhonda Duggan (District 2) as Chair Pro-Tem.

Chair Kreitz, who represents the Mammoth Lakes area, succeeds Supervisor Lynda Salcido (District 5), who led the Board throughout 2025. The transition highlights the Board's commitment to a rotating leadership structure that ensures diverse representation for all regions of the Eastern Sierra.

"I am deeply honored to serve as Chair during this pivotal year for Mono County," said Chair Jennifer Kreitz. "As we move forward with our 2026 strategic goals—including the continued expansion of workforce housing and the strengthening of our community resilience—I am eager to work alongside my colleagues and our dedicated County staff. The Board also took time to formally recognize and thank outgoing Chair Salcido for her exceptional service and dedication over the past year.
