• Know the regulations – including license, seasons, limits, and gear rules.



- Handle fish gently—land quickly, keep them wet, and release them without removing them from the water.
- Use wet hands only never squeeze or touch eyes or gills, and avoid using rags.
- Remove hooks carefully if deeply hooked, clip the line close to the mouth.
- Choose gear wisely use artificial lures, barbless hooks, and avoid using bait to reduce deep hooking.



• Recycle fishing line – use Tangle Free Waters tubes around lakes and marinas.



- Dispose of fish waste properly use designated fish cleaning stations or bear-safe trash cans.
- Respect the land and wildlife stay on trails, avoid spawning areas, and follow wildfire safety rules.
