

# RESPONSIBLE FISHING STARTS **HERE**



- **Know the regulations** — including license, seasons, limits, and gear rules.
- **Handle fish gently** — land quickly, keep them wet, and release them without removing them from the water.
- **Use wet hands only** — never squeeze or touch eyes or gills, and avoid using rags.
- **Remove hooks carefully** — if deeply hooked, clip the line close to the mouth.
- **Choose gear wisely** — use artificial lures, barbless hooks, and avoid using bait to reduce deep hooking.

REGULATIONS

- **Pack out all gear and trash** — leave no hooks, bait containers, or trash behind.
- **Recycle fishing line** — use Tangle Free Waters tubes around lakes and marinas.
- **Dispose of fish waste properly** — use designated fish cleaning stations or bear-safe trash cans.
- **Respect the land and wildlife** — stay on trails, avoid spawning areas, and follow wildfire safety rules.
