Unless otherwise specifically provided, no person is eligible to be elected or appointed to an elective office unless that person is a registered voter and otherwise qualified to vote for that office [EC 201]. PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU ARE REGISTERED WITH NO PARTY PREFERENCE OR HAVE DECLINED TO STATE A PARTY, YOU WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE FOR PRESIDENT IN THE PRIMARY ELECTION UNLESS YOU RE-REGISTER WITH A POLITICAL PARTY OR CHOOSE A CROSS-OVER BALLOT. PLEASE CONTACT OUR OFFICE FOR MORE INFORMATION.
