



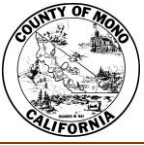

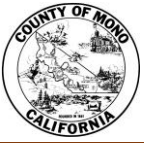
DATE	RESPONSIBLE AGENCY	DESCRIPTION
Nov 1, 2023 (E-125)	District	<i>Deadline for Boundary Maps to be delivered to the Elections Official</i> (E.C. 10522) The secretary of a resident voting district shall deliver to the county elections official of each affected county a map showing the boundaries of the district.
Nov 20, 2023 12:00 pm	District	<i>Consolidation of a Measure with the Primary Election</i> (E.C. 9140, 9160, 9222, 9280, 9313, 10002, 10403) Suggested last day to submit a resolution requesting consolidation to the Board of Supervisors (BOS) for the December 5, 2023 BOS meeting. Resolution should include the request for the Mono County Registrar of Voters to provide services, the ballot question (75-word limit), passage requirements, the full text (including Tax Rate Statement and Fiscal Impact Report, if applicable), and the Impartial Analysis. The request shall be made to the BOS with a copy of the request to the Elections Official for review.
Dec 8, 2023 (E-88)	District	<i>Ballot Measure</i> (E.C. §§ 9312, 10403, 13247) <u>Last day</u> for submission of a resolution calling a measure to the County Elections Official. The resolution shall also specify if the full text of the measure is to be printed in the Sample Ballot. The District Secretary shall deliver a resolution to the Board of Supervisors and the County Elections Official requesting that the County Elections Official conduct the election.
Dec 8, 2023 (E-88)	Elections Official	<i>Transmittal of Resolution</i> Elections Official transmits resolutions to the County Counsel and the County Auditor.

Dec 13, 2023 (E-83)	District	<p><i>Last day to Withdraw a Measure</i> (E.C. § 9605)</p> <p>Whenever a legislative body has ordered that a measure be submitted to the voters of any jurisdiction at an election, the order of election shall not be amended or withdrawn after this date.</p>
Dec 19, 2023 (E-77)	County Counsel	<p><i>Last day to submit Impartial Analysis</i> (E.C. §§ 9313, 9314)</p> <p>Last day for County Counsel to submit impartial analysis to Registrar of Voters. The analysis shall be printed in the pamphlet preceding the arguments for or against the measure. The analysis is limited to 500 words.</p> <p><i>PUBLIC EXAM PERIOD</i> (E.C. § 9380) There will be a 10-day exam period for the Impartial Analysis. The period will be held December 20, 2023 through December 30, 2023.</p>
Dec 19, 2023 (E-77)	Proponents / Opponents	<p><i>Last day to file Arguments</i> (E.C. §§ 9315, 9316, 9600)</p> <p>Last day set by Registrar of Voters to submit arguments in favor or against the measure. Arguments may not exceed 300 words. No more than five signatures shall appear with any arguments. Authors of Argument form shall accompany all arguments.</p> <p><i>PUBLIC EXAM PERIOD</i> (E.C. § 9380) There will be a 10-day exam period for arguments. The period will be held December 20, 2023 through December 30, 2023.</p>
Dec 29, 2023 (E-67)	Proponents / Opponents	<p><i>Last day to file Rebuttals</i> (E.C. §§ 9317, 9600)</p> <p>Last day for the same authors of the primary argument to file rebuttals with the Registrar of Voters no later than 5:00 p.m. Rebuttals are limited to 250 words. Statement of Authors of Arguments form must be attached to the rebuttal.</p> <p><i>PUBLIC EXAM PERIOD</i> (E.C. § 9380) There will be a 10-day exam period for Rebuttals. The period will be held December 30, 2023 through January 9, 2024.</p>

Jan 25, 2024 (E-40)	Registrar of Voters	Mail Sample Ballots and other election materials to voters (E.C. §§ 9312, 9380, 13303) The Registrar of Voters will begin mailing sample ballots on this date.
Jan 25, 2024 (E-40)	Committees / Registrar of Voters	Filing deadline for Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement (G.C. §§ 84200.5, 84200.7) Filing period for 1 st pre-election campaign statement covers transactions from January 1, 2024 through January 20, 2024.
Feb 5, 2024 (E-29)	Registrar of Voters	Mail Vote by Mail ballots (E.C. §§ 3005, 3010, 3017, 3018, 3020, 4000 et seq.) The Registrar of Voters will begin mailing vote by mail ballots on this date.
Feb 20, 2024 * (E-14)	Voters	Close of Registration (E.C. §§ 2106 & 2107) Last day to register or transfer registration for this election.
Feb 21 – Mar 5, 2024 (E-13 to Election Day)	Voters	Conditional Voter Registration (E.C. 2170) Eligible persons who missed the 15-day close of registration may appear in person at the county election official's office and register and vote conditionally for this election.
Feb 22, 2024 (E-12)	Committees / Registrar of Voters	Filing deadline for Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement (G.C. §§ 84200.5, 84200.7) Filing period for 2 nd pre-election campaign statement covers transactions from January 21, 2024 through February 17, 2024.
Mar 5, 2024		Election Day! The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. and will close at 8:00 p.m.
