



A CAREER WITH MONO COUNTY EMS

THE POSITION

The ideal candidate is team-oriented and able to demonstrate the ability to function well as a member of an EMS team. This individual must be capable of working in an environment that is ethnically & culturally diverse. Under general supervision, the candidate must perform the following essential functions that include, but are not limited to:

- Working at an assigned station with one partner on a forty-eight-hour shift.
- Provide Basic Life Support and/or Advanced Life Support treatment to victims, in accordance with California State and ICEMA Region scope of Practice.
- Assists in patient extrication from vehicles involved in traffic collisions, and provides assistance to other agencies, such as Mono County Sheriff's Office, Mono County Search and Rescue, local Fire Departments, United States Forest Service and others.
- Responds into the back county by foot, vehicle, helicopter or by whatever means necessary to render treatment.
- Operates rescue unit in presence of inclement weather, road closures and possible avalanche danger.
- Perform over-the-side rescues of victims as trained.
- Responds to the fire ground to treat victims of fire, explosions, or building collapse. Assists with emergency incident rehabilitation on the fire ground as assigned.
- Perform Ice Rescue of victims as trained.
- Complete electronic patient run report in a timely and accurate manner.

- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Emergency medical techniques
- Rescue techniques
- Defensive driving
- Vehicle and equipment maintenance

- Possession of a valid Driver's license
- Possession of valid BLS (Basic Life Support) card.
