SCE Mammoth Lakes Storage Area One

As part of SCE's wildfire mitigation plan, inspections in critical fire areas have been performed to identify necessary system repairs and upgrades. SCE's Mammoth Lakes Storage Area One at 164 Industrial Circle in Mammoth Lakes, will act as material storage and contractor show up yards for crews making the repairs and upgrades identified as part of the inspection process.

Storage Area One

Storage Area One is a cleared and mostly level area within an existing industrial park. Earthen berms border the north and east sides of the yard, an existing block wall to the west and a chain link fence to the south.

The yard will operate from 6 am to 6 pm, or from sunrise to sunset, depending on the time of year. Storage Area One will act as a material storage yard for poles, composite arms, frames, insulators and other materials required to complete upgrades and repairs of the existing electrical system. Personal vehicles will be stored on site during the day and crew trucks and forklifts will be staged overnight and on weekends. A mobile security guard will be onsite during non-working hours.

Portable restrooms, serviced by an authorized service provider at regular intervals, will be maintained on site. Trash receptacles and recycling bins will be maintained on site and serviced by an authorized service provider.

Dust control will be provided by water trucks on an as needed basis. Operation of the site will be consistent with surrounding uses and is not anticipated to generate potential nuisances.




Figure 1. Site Plan Storage Area One and Crew Show-up Area Southern California Edison Mono County, California
