LTC Co-Executive Director Report September 6, 2022

Administration

- FY 2021-2022 Closeout for the Overall Work Program (OWP) was completed.
- The annual audit for the LTC is being initiated.
- The triennial audit for transit for the past two cycles is being initiated.
- Staff continues to attend the CalSTA (California State Transportation Agency) meetings on Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) implementation nothing new to report at this time.

Projects/Programs

- Memorandum of Understand (MOU) funds: Staff is meeting in early September with Kern Council of Governments (COG) staff to provide introductions and establish new relationships prior to inviting Commissioners to participate in a discussion regarding MOU funds.
- State Route (SR) 120 access: Staff met with Yosemite National Park staff in late August to discuss access concerns on SR 120. The Park Service was unavailable for the September LTC meeting but will present at a future meeting and hold a public meeting in Lee Vining in October. LTC staff and Mono County Economic Development Department staff are assisting with the logistics.
- **Reds Meadow Road update:** The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) was unavailable for the September LTC meeting to provide an update on the Reds Meadow Road project and will present at a future meeting.
- West Walker River Parkway project: The County was not awarded a grant it applied for earlier in the year to construct recreation features on these County-owned lands to the south of Walker. Staff efforts will refocus on completing the West Walker River Parkway Plan with technical assistance through a grant from the National Park Service.
