- YARTS buses are ADA accessible.
- The YARTS 395/120 route is scheduled to run through September 30, 2024. Please note that there will only be one run a day September 1, 2024 through September 30, 2024.
- Applicant must be 18 years of age and older, and a resident of Mono County.
- One free ticket voucher will be issued per resident per application. The ticket voucher will cover the cost of the Applicant's round-trip ticket, as well as the cost of round-trip tickets for the Applicant's children aged 0-17.
- All applicants must submit proof of address (government issued identification, vehicle registration, signed lease, utility bill, etc.) to verify residency. If using a utility bill, both the service address and the mailing address must be visible and located in Mono County.
- Pickup/Dropoff Locations include Mammoth Lakes, June Lake, Lee Vining, Tuolumne Meadows, White Wolf, Crane Flat, and Yosemite Valley. Please see <u>www.yarts.com/routes/mammoth-lakes-hwy-120e-395/</u> for more info.

- Eligible participants will receive a voucher that can be used to make a reservation online, via the YARTS website, <u>www.YARTS.com</u>. Vouchers can be picked up in person at either the Bridgeport or Mammoth Lakes Community Development office or delivered via mail or email. PLEASE ALLOW UP TO FIVE BUSINESS DAYS AFTER SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION AND PROOF OF RESIDENCY DOCUMENTS FOR THE VOUCHER TO BE ISSUED.
- Each voucher code may only be used once and only one voucher code may be used per transaction.
- Ticket vouchers will be distributed based on available funding and in the order in which they are received.
