1. Opportunity for the Public to Address the Board

- Supervisor Jennifer Kreitz mentioned that the minutes from February have her last name misspelled and requests before the minutes are adopted, a change be made.

2. Five Year Strategic Plan Update

Interim Probation Chief Jazmin Barkley presented the final Strategic Plan and recommends the plan be adopted.

- Members described the strategies and provided some ideas on how to address them.
- Concern around data tracking was brought up and the data tracking tool was addressed.
- Jazmin explained if plan is adopted, next steps would be to address the strategies

3. FY 2025-2026 Budget Review

Kasandra, Probation's FASO, provided an overview of the FY 2025-2026 revenues, expenditures, and the current fund balance. Reporting that the budget is on track.

4. FY 2026-2027 Budget Request Proposals

- MLPD Sgt. Heilman provided a presentation for the request of AXON AI translation and Draft One for a funding request of \$28,266 yearly for five years, which would be a total of \$113,564. Concern of AI use in report writing were brought up and questions as to whether the Town of Mammoth Lakes is willing to fund.
- Interim Chief Barkley presented two proposals. First one was for AXON AI translation services for a total funding request of \$11,964.23. The second proposal was to enhance the Re-entry Program to include emergency housing, food, clothing, long distance transportation, cell phones/phone plan, and incentives for a total request of \$23,000.

5. Public Defender Representative Update

Jeremy Ibrahim as the Public Defender will be the representative for the Public Defenders in the CCP and will replace Sophie Bidet.

6. CCP Member Updates – Roundtable

None reported.

7. Transition to CCP Executive Committee

Transition was announced, some committee members stayed for the Executive Committee discussion.

8. Executive Committee Minutes
