**1. Opportunity for the Public to Address the Council**

On items of public interest that are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Council (speakers may be limited in speaking time depending upon the press of business and number of people wishing to address the Council).

**2. Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council Minutes**

Approval of April 23, 2025, Minutes. No minutes to approve for October 25, 2025, as meeting was cancelled due to lack of attendance.

- Only DA Anderson was present at this meeting; therefore, minutes could not be approved. They will be tabled for next meeting.
- No action taken.

**3. JJCC Meeting Calendar**

Discussion of proposed Meeting Calendar for 2026: January 21, 2026; April 15, 2026; July 15, 2026; and October 21, 2026. Does the third Wednesday at 1:00 p.m. still work?

- April 15<sup>th</sup> conflicted with most of the Council members' schedules. Therefore, it was proposed this meeting be moved to April 29<sup>th</sup>.
- Action: Tammy made a motion to approve the dates for 2026 with the change of April 15<sup>th</sup> to April 29<sup>th</sup>. Dave seconds. Council approves unanimously.

**4. Risking Connection: Advancing Trauma-Informed Care and Racial Trauma Healing**

Molly DesBaillets to present program. Discussion whether the program meets JJCC criteria and if it should be funded and supported by the JJCC.

- Molly presented the Risking Connection Change Model and explained its purpose.

- Discussion regarding cost, whether it would align with the JJCC purpose, training concerns, and whether it adds to staffs skills.
- JJCC requests Traumatic Stress Institute provide a presentation to further explain the concept of the model.
- No action. Presentation will be scheduled for the April 29, 2026, meeting.

**5. Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act & Youthful Offender Block Grant (JJCPA-YOBG) 2025-2026 Consolidated Annual Plan**

JJCC to review current plan for 2024-2025 and determine if any changes need to be made. Changes to be made by next meeting April 22, 2026. This report is due May 1, 2026.

- Discussion: Most JJCC members at this meeting are new and would like to understand if prior plans have been successful in reducing juvenile crime and delinquency by providing prevention, intervention, and treatment to youth.
- No action. JJCC requests data be provided at the April 29<sup>th</sup> meeting and transparency of the JJCPA/YOBG funding.

**6. Round Table**

Opportunity for members to highlight ongoing work, challenges, and opportunities relevant to juvenile prevention efforts. *No action will be taken on this item.*

- Chief Casabian mentioned that MLPD has six vacancies currently; hence, no SRO is currently at the schools.
- Molly provided a brief overview of in-home services.
- Krista provided a positive update of the increase of RFA homes in Mono County. In addition, social worker staffing is improving as a new social worker was just hired.
