2. Public Comment on items not on the agenda.

3. Approval of Minutes from May 8, 2014 meeting.

Moved Vahl, Second Schnadt - Unanimous approval

4. Upcoming public discussions regarding Solid Waste – receive input from SWTF on topics of interest that should be discussed.

*No comments on upcoming discussions.* 

5. SWTF Bylaws—Next steps to bring amended bylaws to County Supervisors and Town Council for approval. Consideration of and recommendations for SWTF members.

Discussion was postponed as Town representative was not present.

6. Review and discussion of update to Final Drafts of Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan Elements.

Discussion about language relating to "Proximity to communities" in the NDFE—would that preclude multiple facilities? Discussion and conclusion was that the language implies that multiple facilities are anticipated, and that it would not preclude multiple facilities.

Clarification on concept of 'commuting distances' -- in Mammoth, commuting distances are short—4 blocks could be considered commuting distance. In Lee Vining, commuting distance is longer. The upshot is that in Mammoth, a 20 mile commute to a Transfer Station is not necessarily acceptable but in Lee Vining it could be.

Group was informed that the next SWTF meeting should have an action item to approve and recommend the policies followed by the BOS approval along with the General Plan.
