### **USFS** Update:

Jeff Ulrich reporting:

The Forest Service had identified tree hazards at several area campgrounds. Trees had been "dropped" and opened up for wood gathering. Most of the wood has already been removed.

The Wheeler Stream restoration plan is nearing completion.

The first stage of the Pinon removal program is 29,000 acres of trees in the East Walker. A mobile chipper was brought in Long Doctor near Sweetwater Summit. The chipper was quickly shut-down due to the unanticipated impacts to the ground from the chipping unit.

Two new projects were mentioned: - Desert Creek (Smith Valley side) Rosaschi Ranch east field is being re-seeded after the USFS purchased the property and turned off the irrigation water and – Spring Creek fire re-vegetation with bitterbush and sage brush.

#### Mountain Gate:

Ardin Gerbig reported:

Phase 2 of Mountain Gate is deferred until spring 2015. The project has been downsized somewhat in hopes that we can obtain a bid that meets our budget.

Suggested that we start addressing what we want for Phase III of Mountain Gate. This includes the County property that connects the Mtn Gate Park with East Side Lane. To be added to next month's agenda.

Election turnout was low – 29.9% statewide and 53% for Mono County.

Phase 2 Mtn Gate bidding process has been re-authorized with scaled back plans with options. Bridgeport biomass heater ??. Reminded the community that woodchips are free at the dump.
