Public Comment:

M. Curti announced that burning season has begun. Last year's permit will be good through 12-31-2014 To burn, one must call Sacramento to confirm that it will be a burn day and then call the Mono Co. Sherriff's office (760) 932-7549 #7.

Van Lente has taken over as the manager of the Health Clinic, 73 Camp Antelope Rd. in Walker. He indicates that plans are for either an MD or PA to be available 5 days a week and a dentist after 01-01-2015.

Approval of Minutes:

Minutes for November 6, 2014 approved.

<u>Informational / Discussion of Actions:</u>

Ulrich indicated that the Forest has planted 6,000 sage/bitterbrush plantings and further seeding at Rosaschi Ranch. Snow mobiles will be allowed in designated areas after it is determined that there is 24" of snow accumulation.

Power reported that the Marine Base is gearing up for winter training.

Language described a faulty announcement of intentions by the Marines to install seven story communication towers. In discussion, both Ulrich and Power said they would look into it and report back to the RPAC. Fesko/Language recommended that the comment period be extended and a presentation be made to the RPAC.

Fesko announced that the County had received six bids for the Mountain Gate Park construction, which will go forward in spring, 2015. Part of the contract will be the stewardship of plantings for a year, including weekly watering. Low bidder was Sierra View Equipment.

LeFrancois said the Opticos planning is active and continuing.
