June Lake Citizen Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes April 5, 2016

Jeff Ronci called the meeting to order at 7:06 pm. Committee members present include Jeff Ronci, John Logue, Bob Gardner and Patti Heinrich.

The March 1, 2016 minutes were reviewed and a motion was made by John and seconded by Jeff, The vote was unanimous and the minutes were adopted.

Public Comment – None

Supervisor Alpers gave his report, which included attending the Fred Hall Show and there was a lot of interest in the Eastern Sierra regarding fishing this season. He also reported that there will be bus service this summer in the Loop. There is \$128,000 of county funds and \$75,000 from the Town of Mammoth Lake that will be used for fish stocking. Tim will include the Conway Ranch Facility Plan on the June Lake CAC agenda.

Community Center Remodel – a presentation was made explaining the scope of work and an estimated \$5,000 was needed to fund the project. The June Lake Women's club stated they did not want to contribute any funds. The committee was in agreement with the proposed remodel and Supervisor Alpers stated he would talk to Joe Blanchard to obtain more information regarding what upgrades are planned from the county.

June Lake retaining wall proposal- Amanda and Dave provided the committee with a new picture showing the proposed painting. All members of the committee agreed and Amanda had a support signature form which members of the committee signed. Amanda stated that all but one of their neighbors has been contacted and all like the idea. Next step is to meet with Caltrans for their approval.

Sustainable Agriculture – was tabled until next meeting.

Skate Park – No new report

Development in June Lake – There was a work shop regarding the TROD with the BOS and Planning Commission. The results of the TROD workshop will be on the next Planning Commission agenda. There is currently a TROD moratorium in effect. There is a Director Review from the Village that is under consideration.
