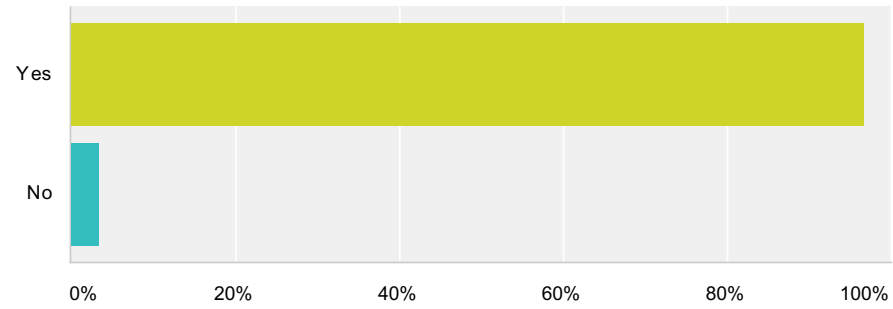


Q1 Do you live or own property in Long Valley?

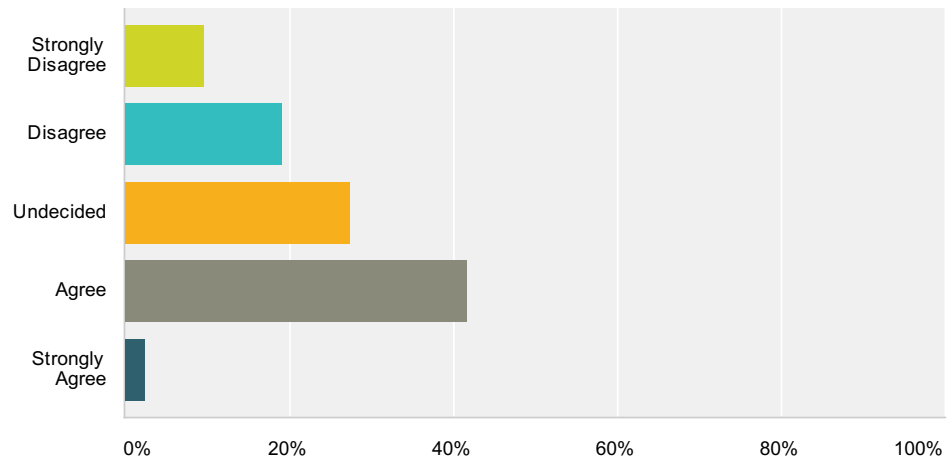

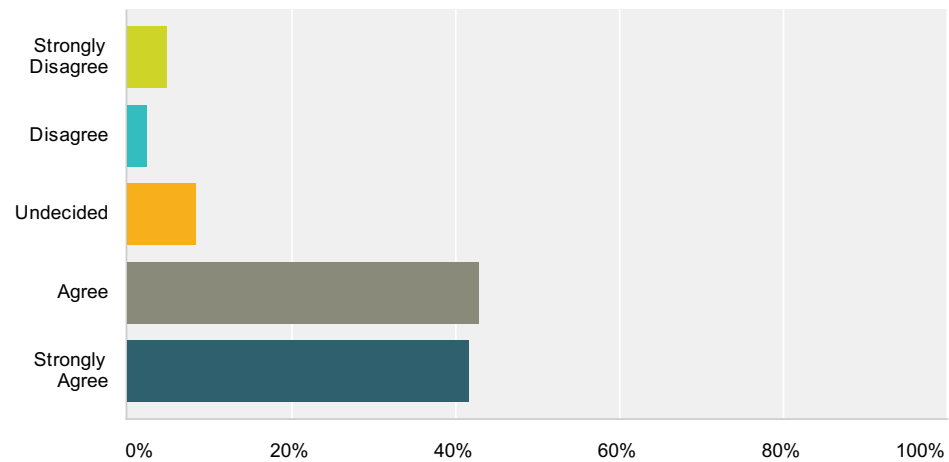

Q3 Access to recycling programs is important

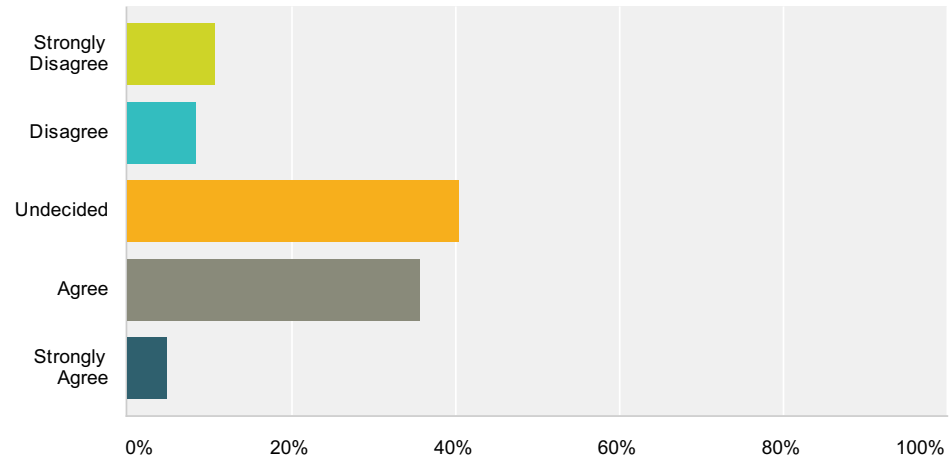

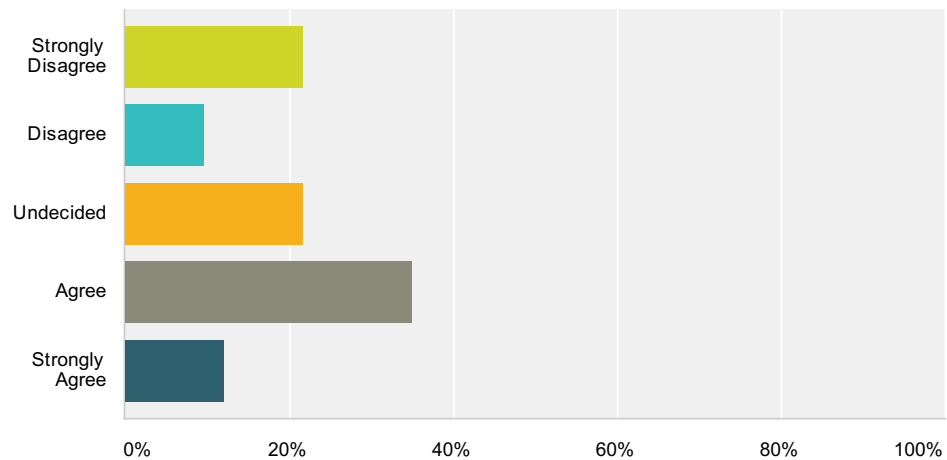

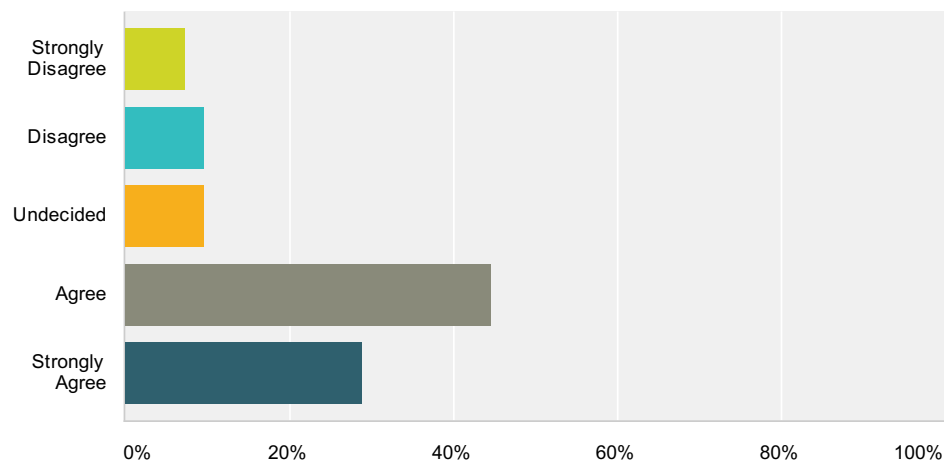

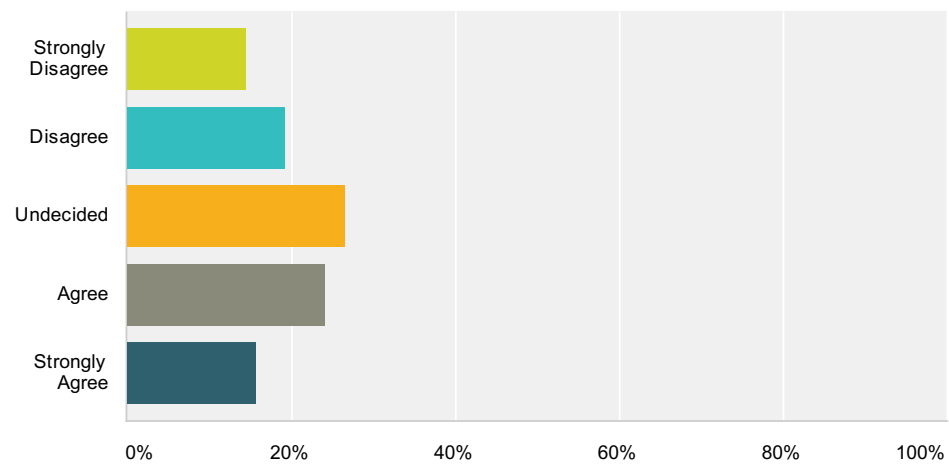

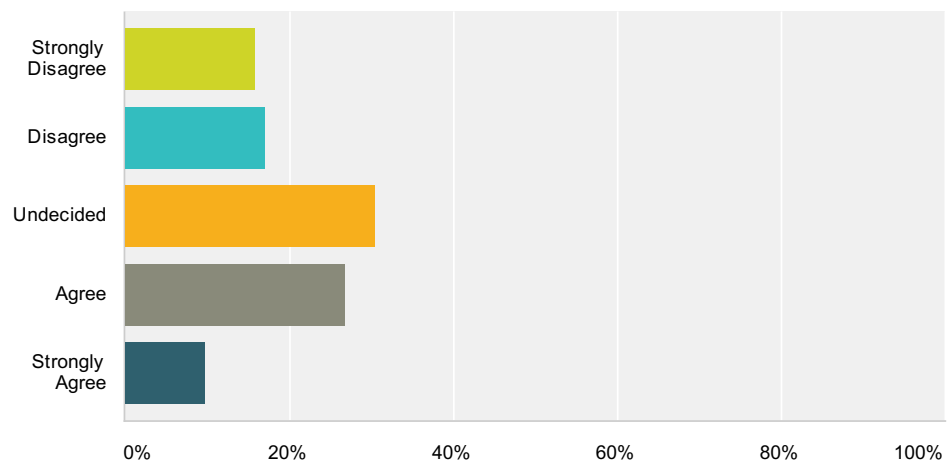

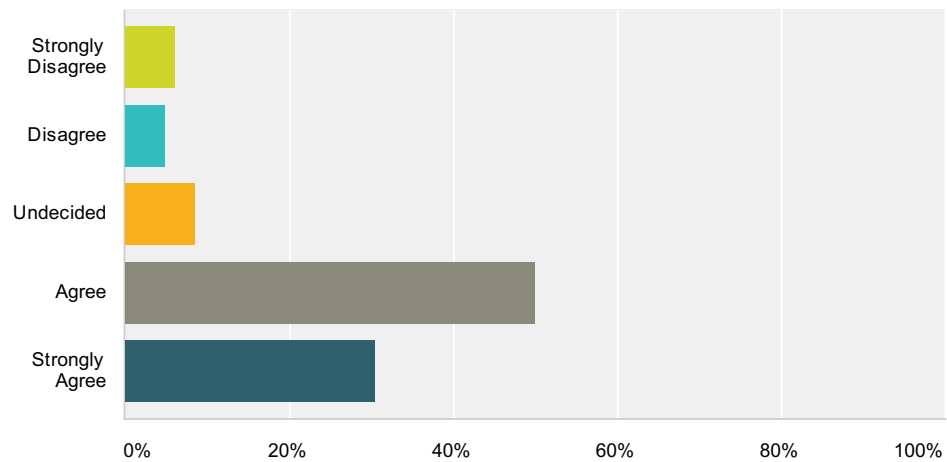

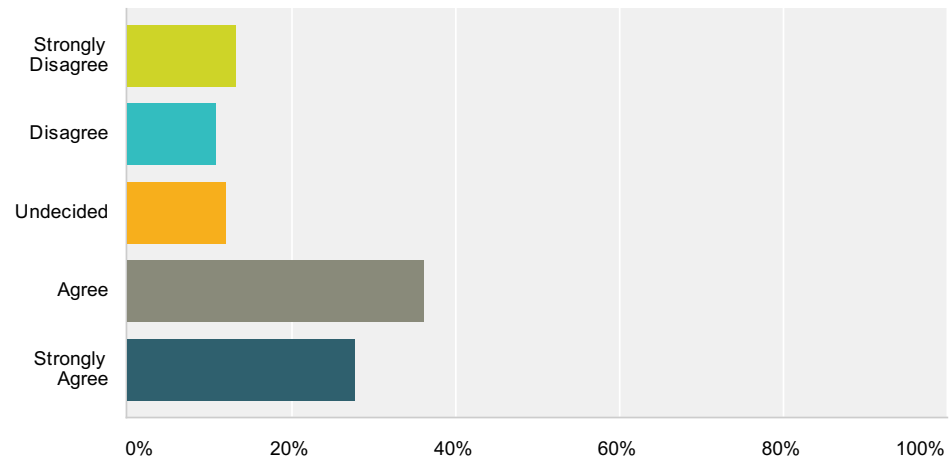

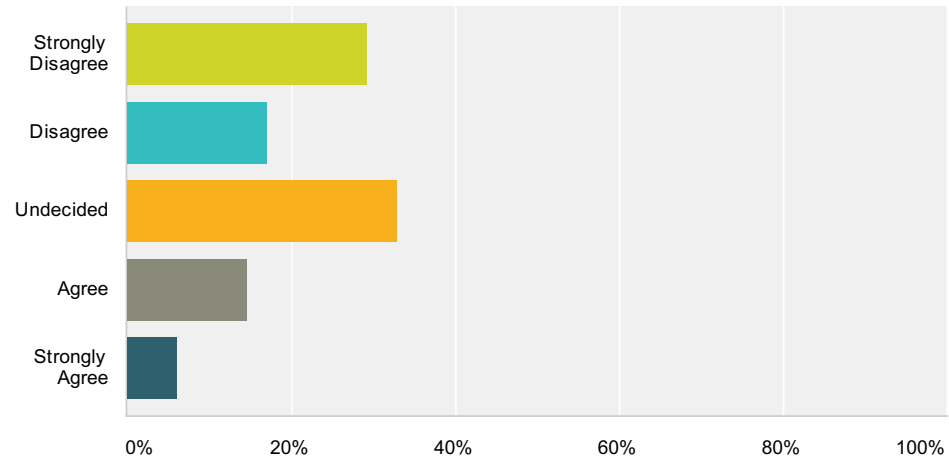

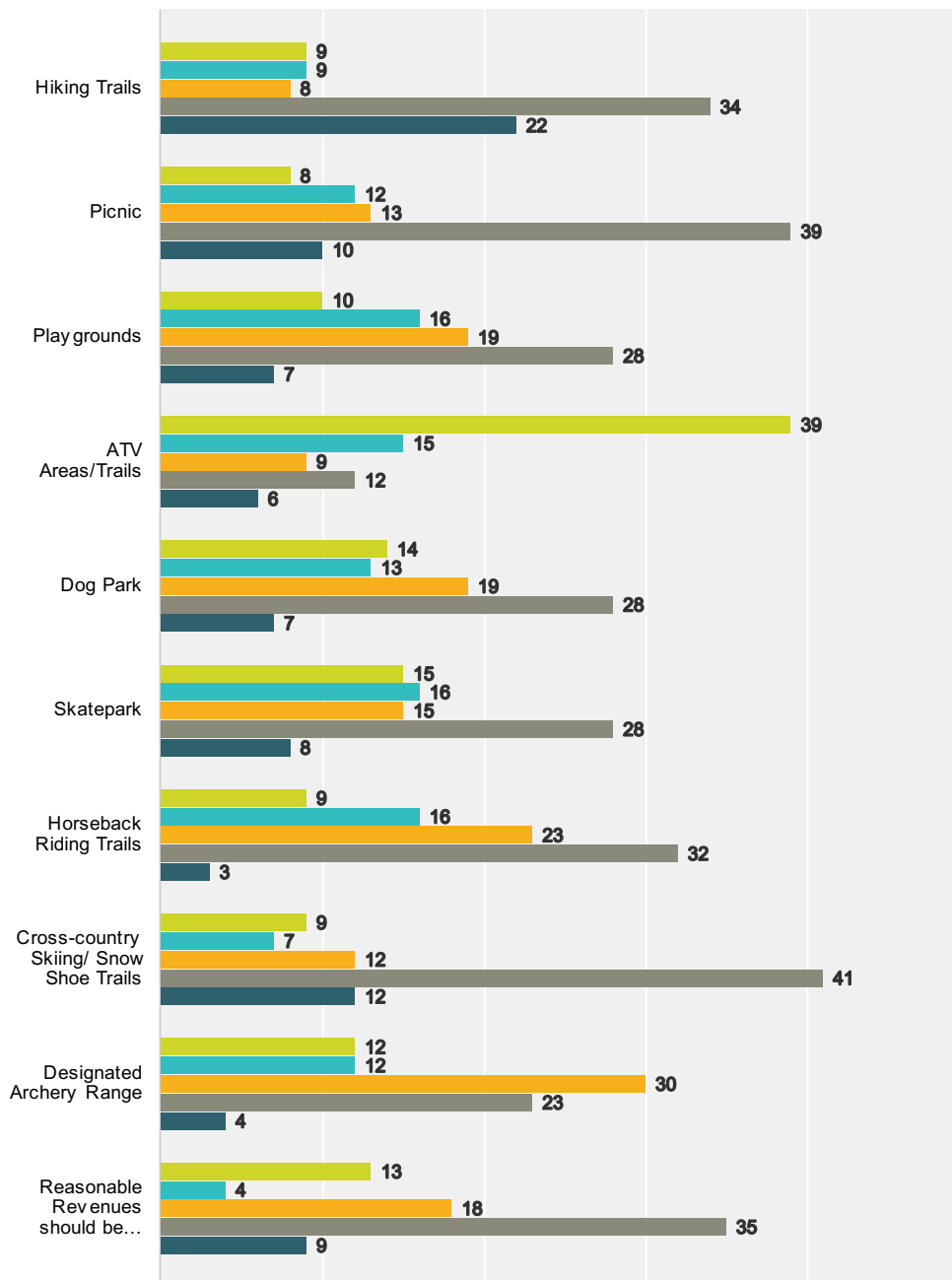

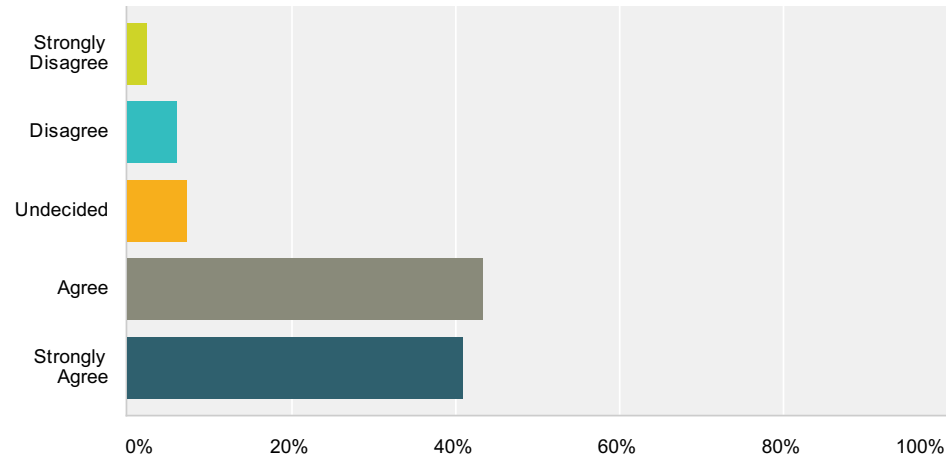

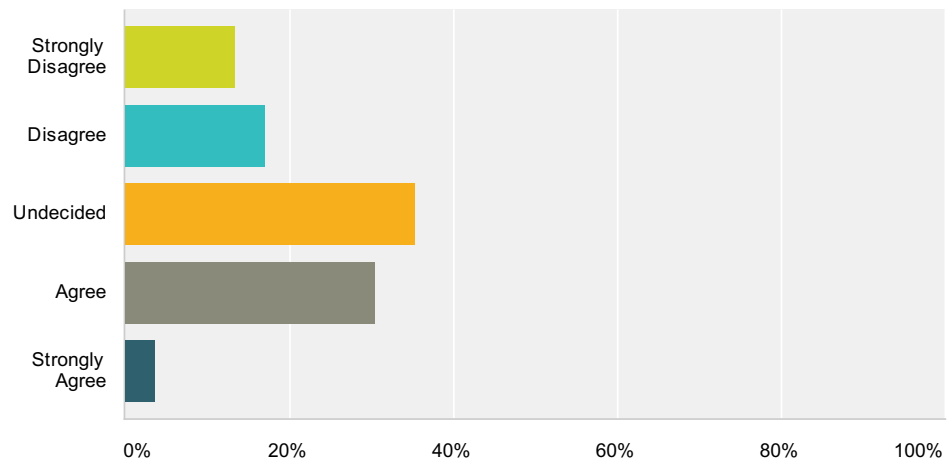

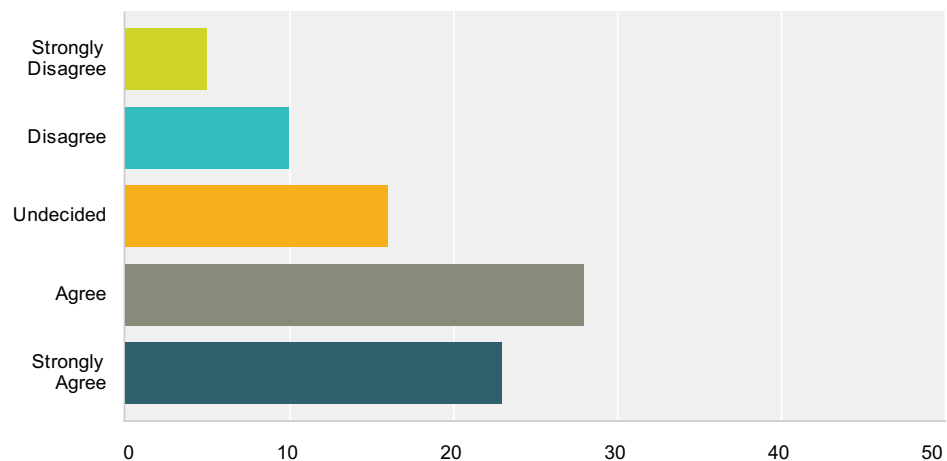

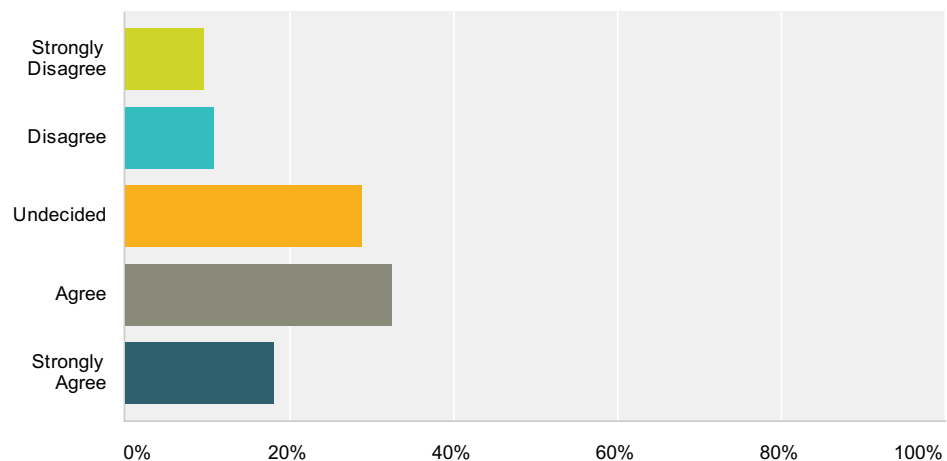

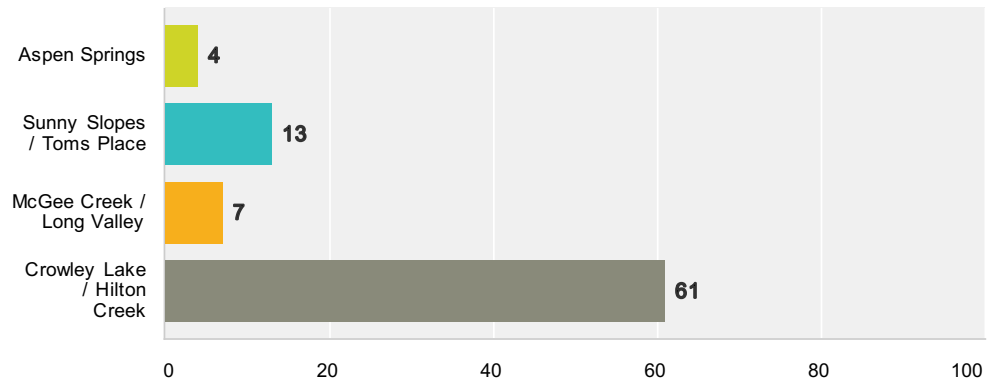

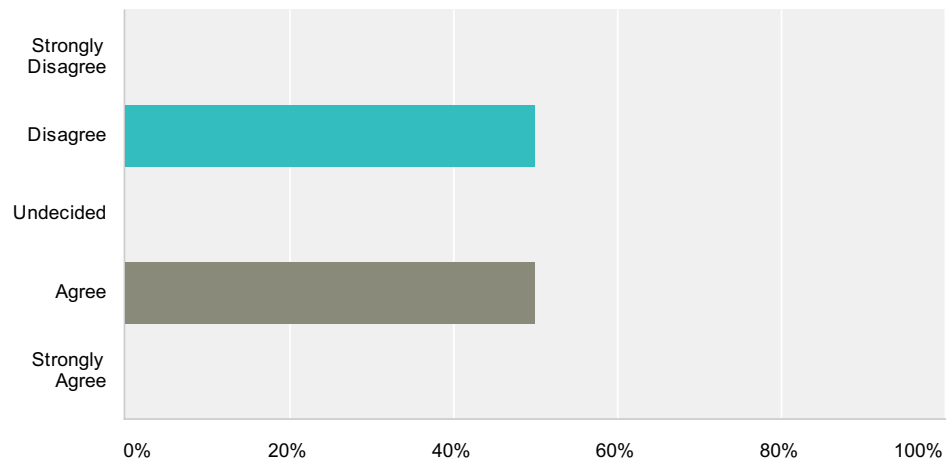

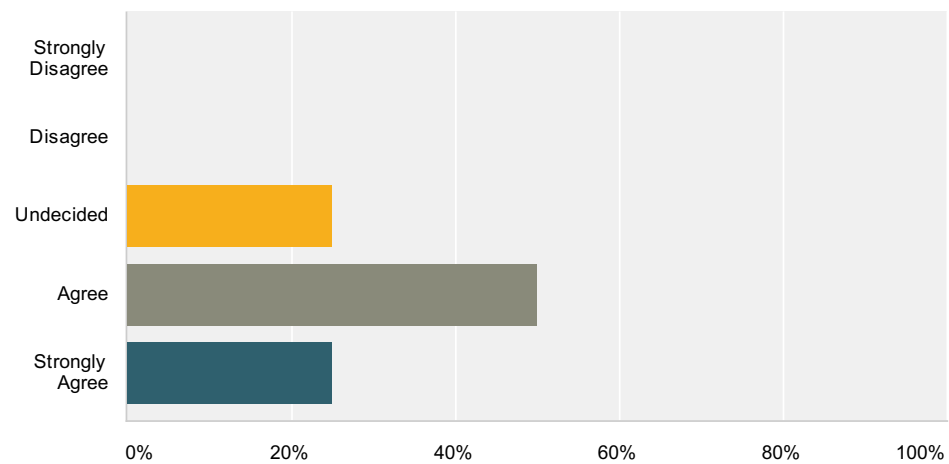

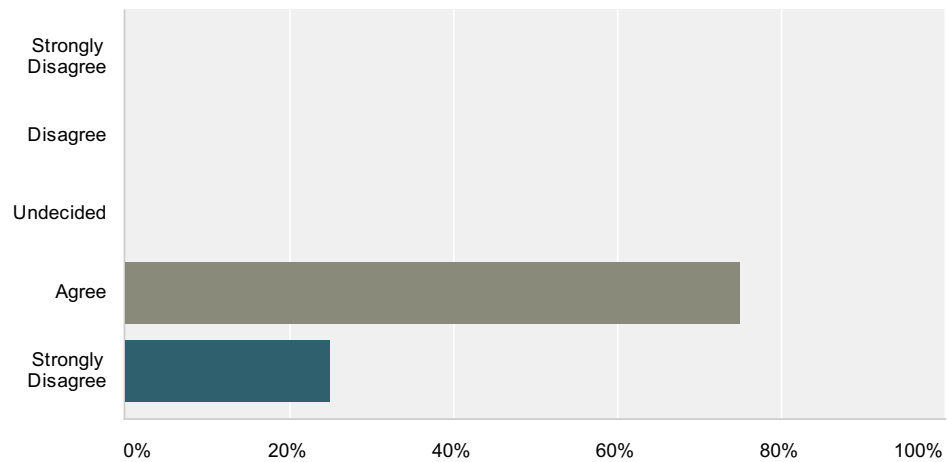

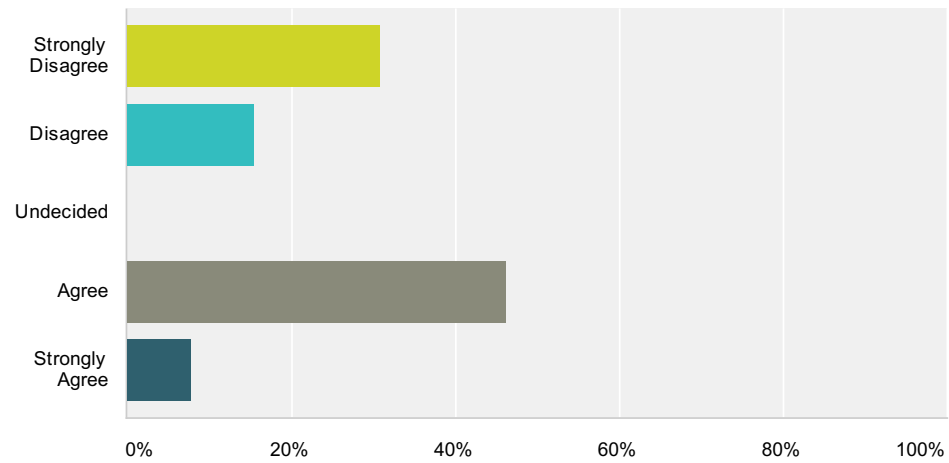

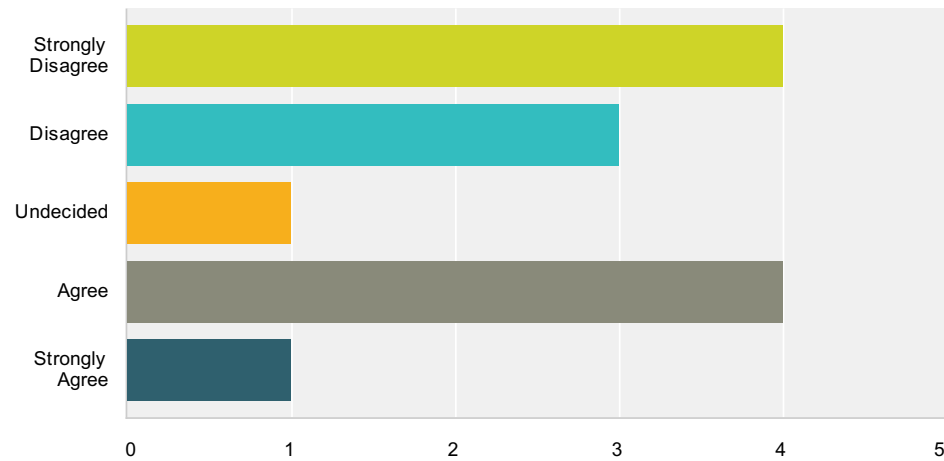

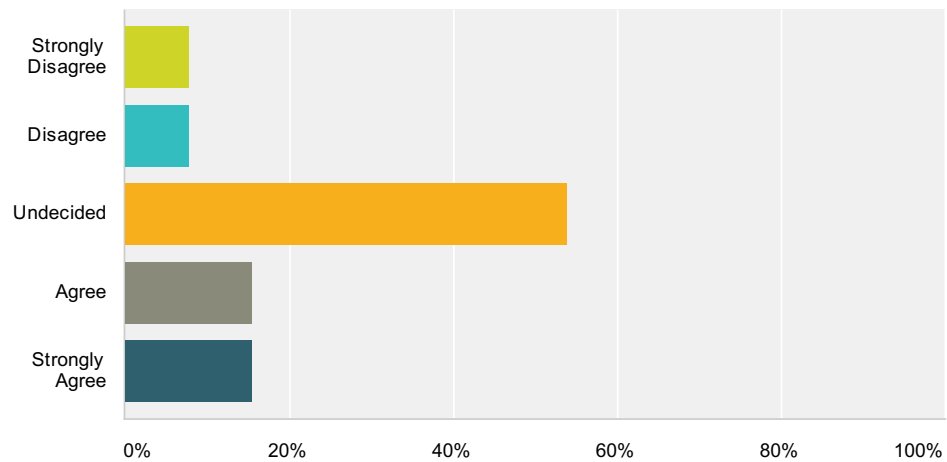

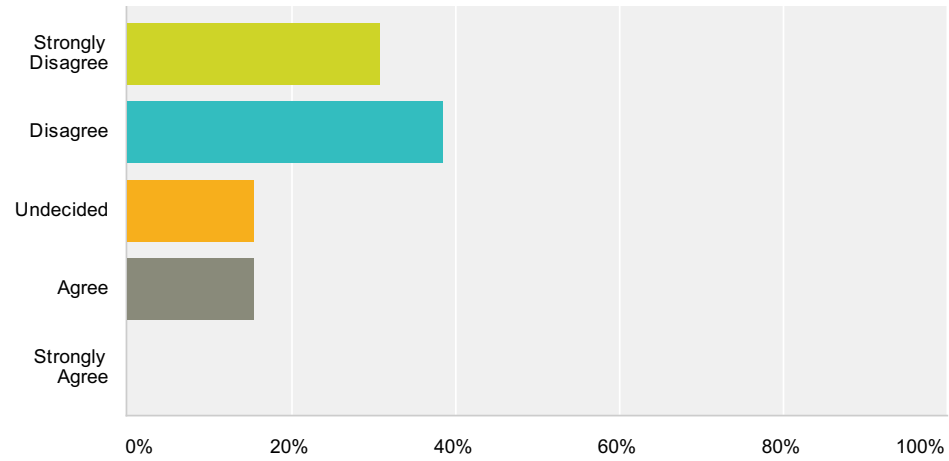

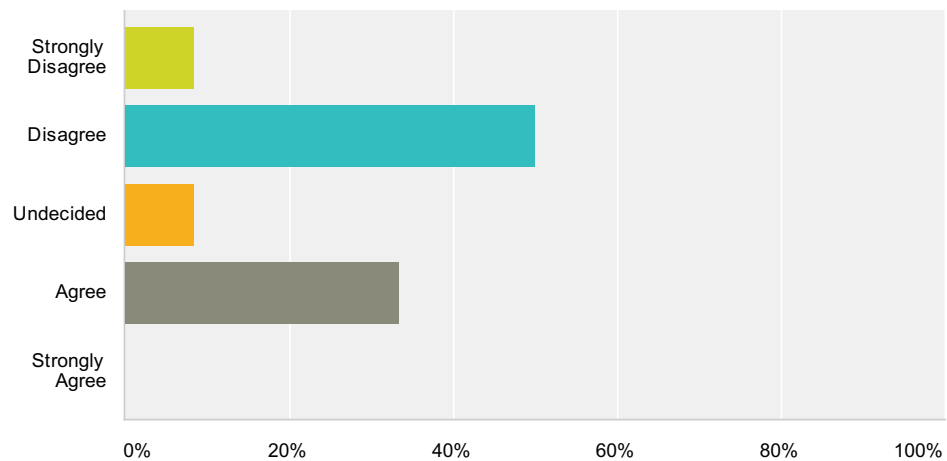

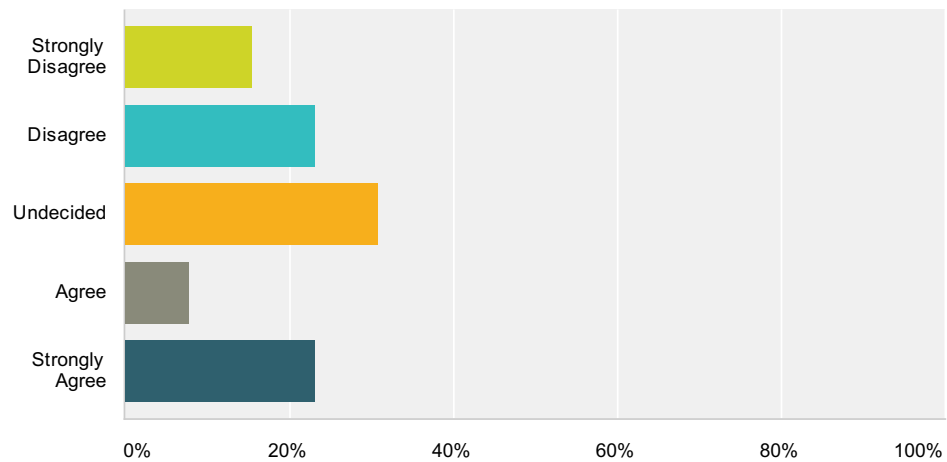

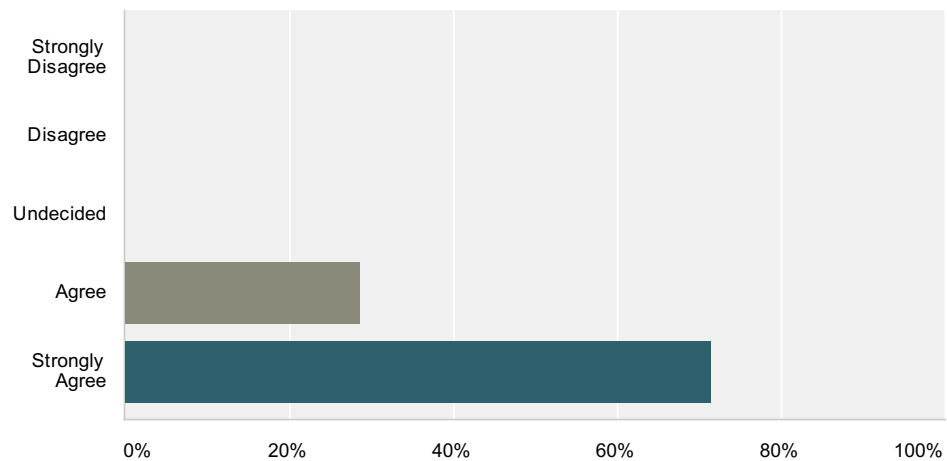

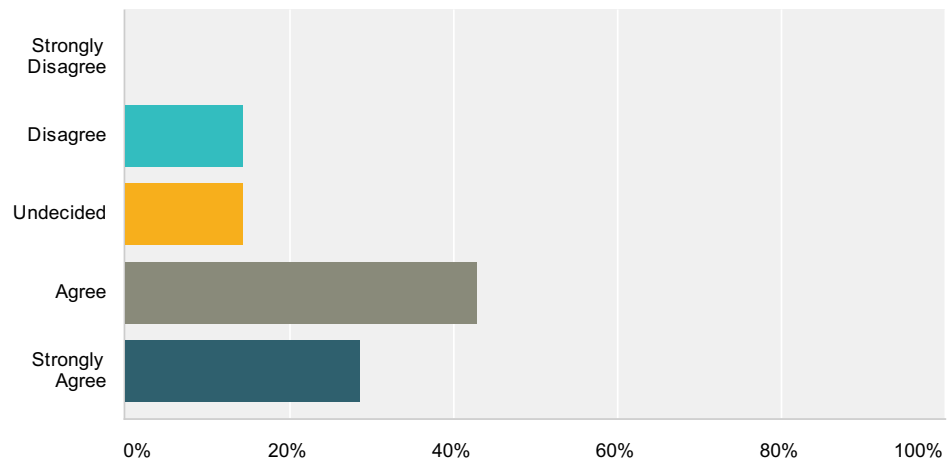

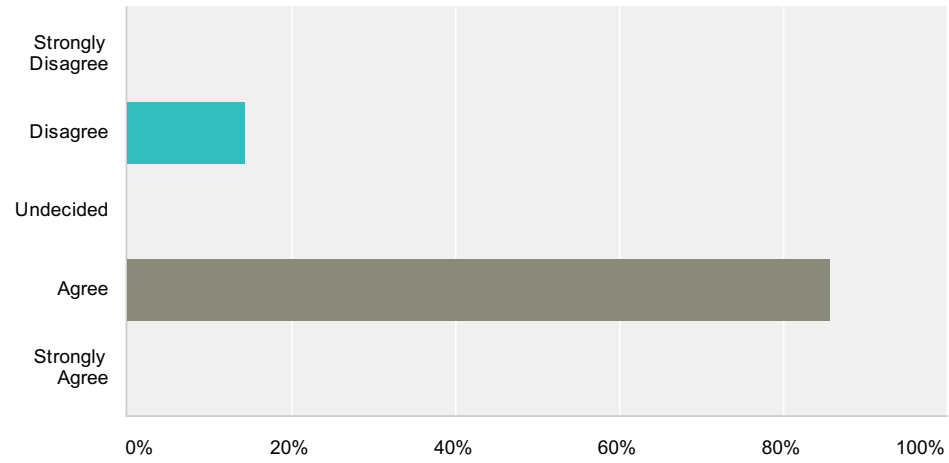

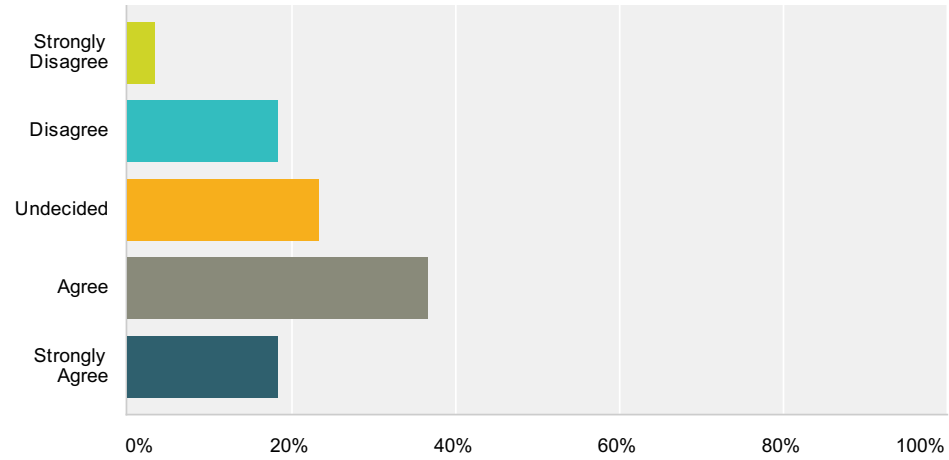

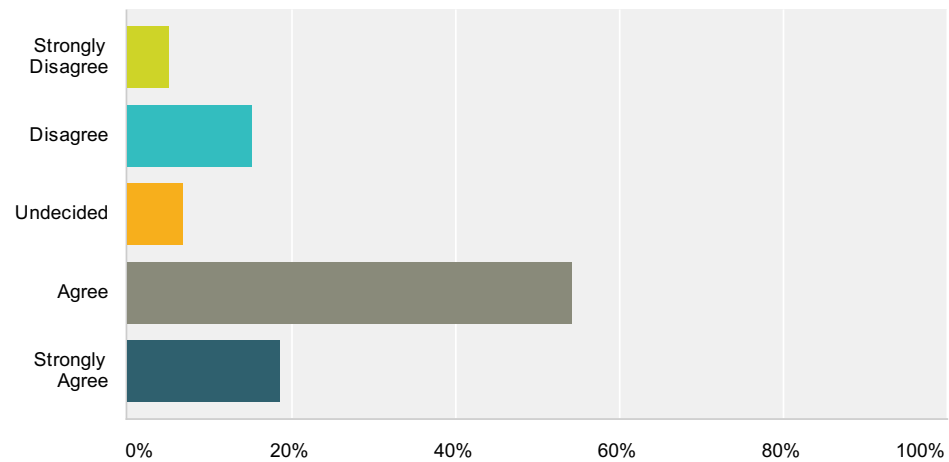

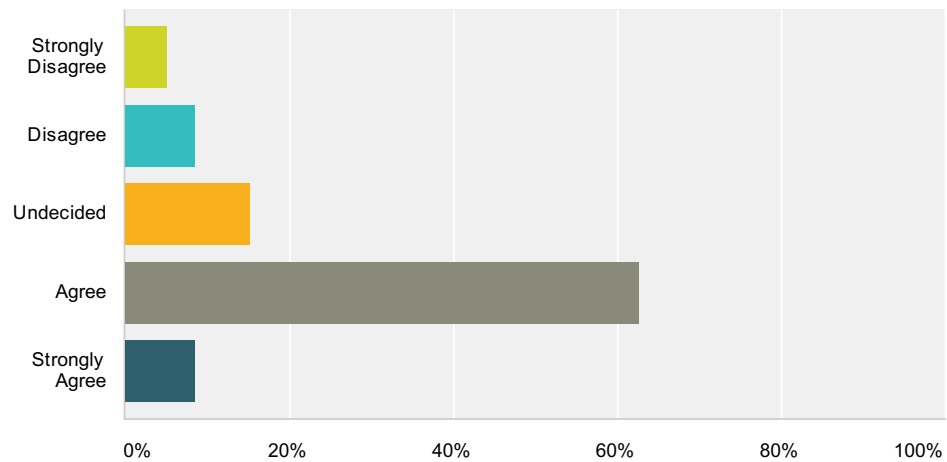

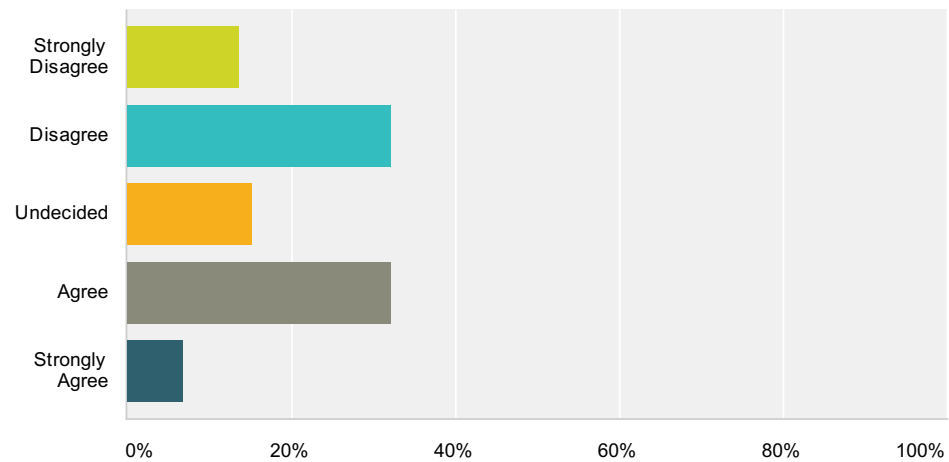

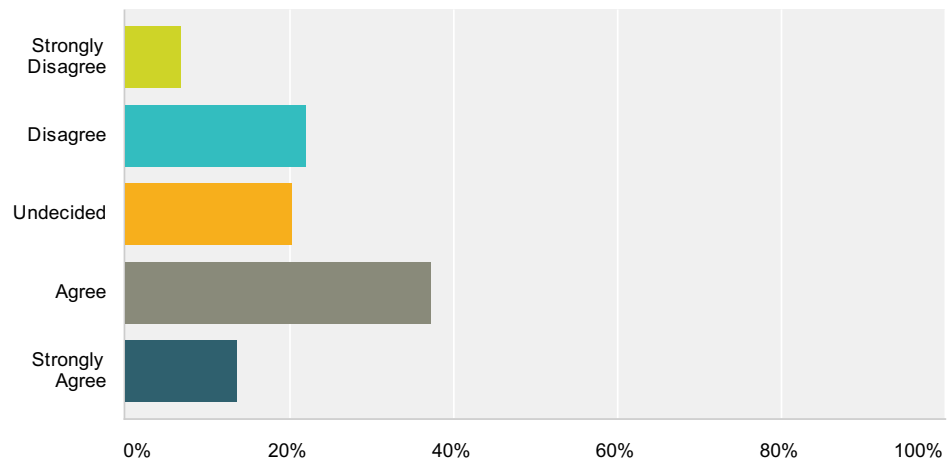

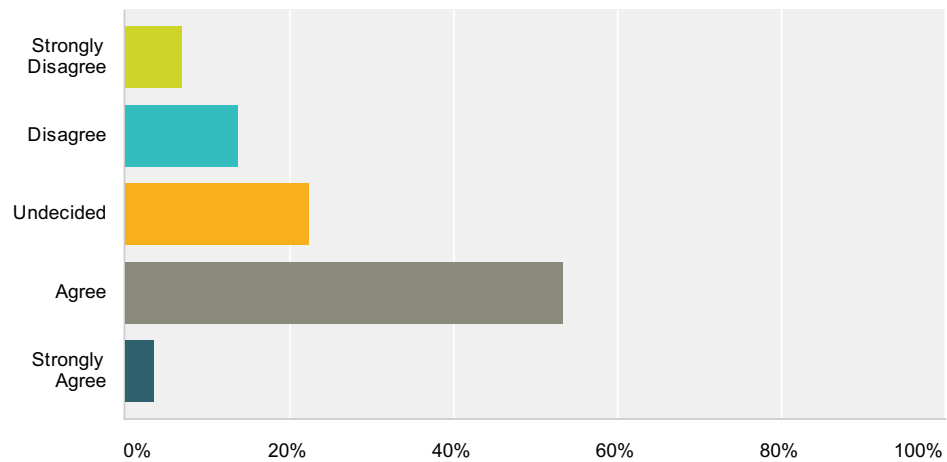

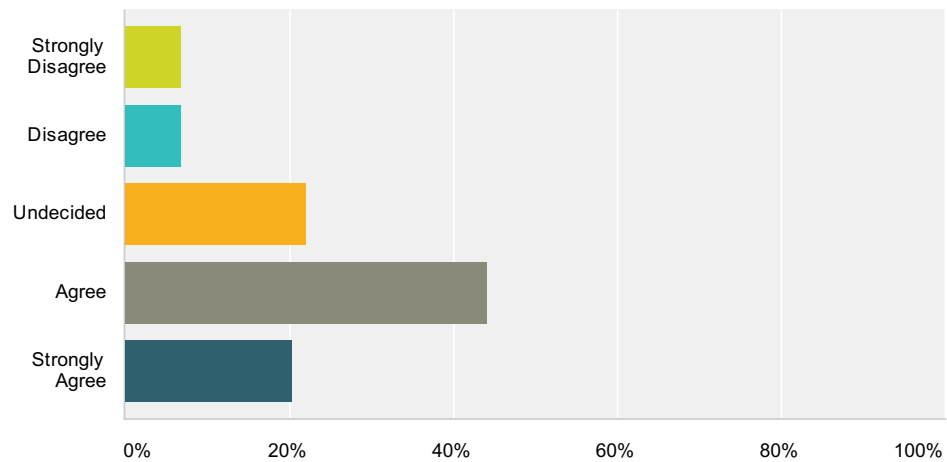

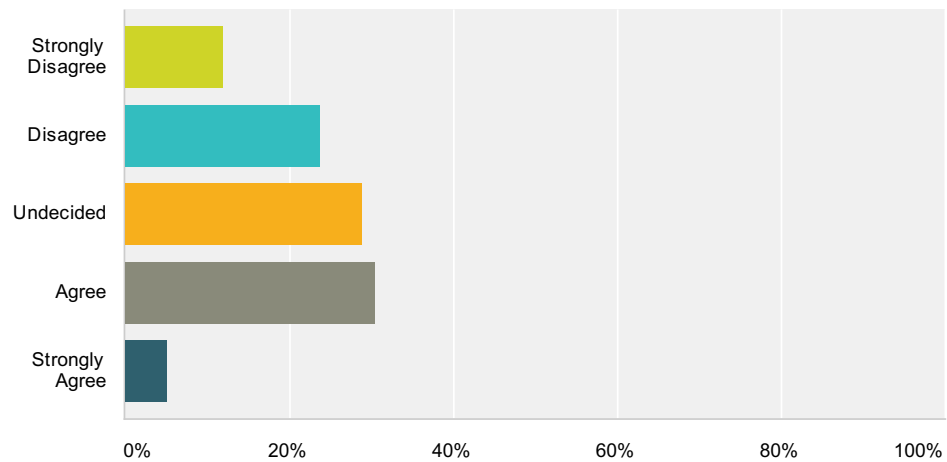

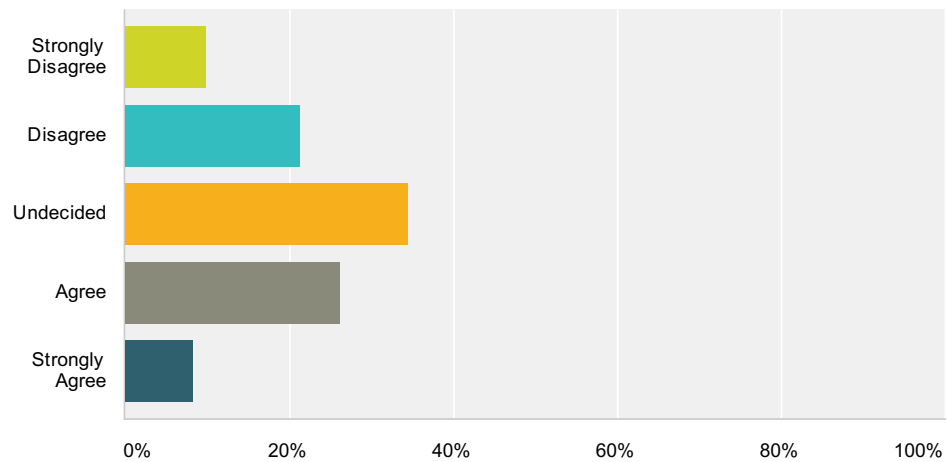
