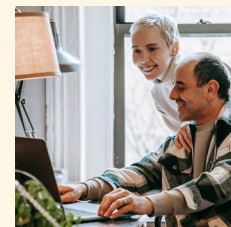

Mexican “Consulate on Wheels” to be in Bishop October 24-27

The Consulate on Wheels will be held at Cerro Coso Community College in Bishop, located at 4090 West Line Street ([map](#)), from October 24-27. This program is run through the Consulate in Fresno: consulmex.sre.gob.mx/fresno/index.php/es.



Mono County residents will be able to apply for a Mexican passport, and Mono and Inyo County residents can submit applications for dual citizenship.

Inyo County residents who need a form of identification from the Mexican government, such as a passport, consular registration, voting card, OP7 form, or certified copy of a birth certificate, can call the numbers below for more information.

TAKE 3 ACTIONS TO FIGHT FLU

Influenza (flu) is a contagious disease that can be serious. Every year, millions of people get sick, hundreds of thousands are hospitalized, and thousands to tens of thousands of people die from flu. CDC urges you to take the following actions to protect yourself and others from flu.

GET YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY VACCINATED!

A yearly flu vaccine is the first and most important step in protecting against flu viruses.

Everyone 6 months or older should get an annual flu vaccine. Protect Yourself. Protect Your Family. Get Vaccinated. #FightFlu

STOP THE SPREAD

Take everyday preventive actions to help stop the spread of flu viruses!

Avoid close contact with sick people, avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth, cover your coughs and sneezes, wash your hands often (with soap and water).

ASK YOUR DOCTOR ABOUT FLU ANTIVIRALS

Take antiviral drugs if your doctor prescribes them!

Antiviral drugs can be used to treat flu illness and can make illness milder and shorten the time you are sick.

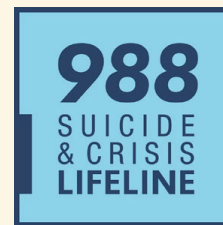
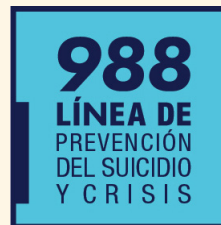

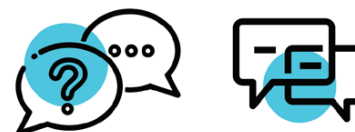
