# **Beware of EBT Theft and Scams!**

California has been experiencing an increase in occurrence of Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) theft. It is important to learn how to recognize these scams to avoid it happening to you.

The California Department of Social Services is providing security tips for those who use EBT cards to receive food (SNAP) and cash aid with a short YouTube video. Click this link to watch, or scan the QR code: www.youtube.com/watch?v=opg52FxKoSo.



# The video outlines how public assistance benefits can be stolen from EBT cards using:

- Text message and phone scams
- Card skimming technology
- Fake websites

## A few tips to avoid scams:

- Don't click on links in text messages or respond to EBTrelated messages. Your county or the state will **never** text you or call you requesting your personal information such as EBT card number, PIN, or date of birth.
- "Number spoofing" is when scammers can make their number look like one you trust, so a text message or phone call may appear to come from a legitimate source. If you're unsure, contact us directly.
- Skimmers are put over ATMs and retailer terminals to skim/copy your card information. The video contains pictures and tips for how to spot one.
- To avoid small, secret cameras recording your PIN, always cover your hand when you're entering your PIN.
- Always check the URL of the website you're on. The official California EBT website is <u>www.ebtproject.ca.gov</u>. It's important to note that the real site ends in **ca.gov**. If you see a URL that ends in something else, it's fake, and you should close the page.
- The same goes for fake email addresses. Scam emails will come from an email address that doesn't match who they claim to be.
- Don't be pressured into making a quick decision. A person from the government or legitimate business won't mind if you take your time in getting back to them. Scammers, on the other hand, will push you so you don't have time to think.

## Remember to be aware and be skeptical!

If you think your benefits may have been stolen, you should immediately call the customer service telephone number on the back of your EBT card: 877-328-9677, or contact Mono County Social Services at 760-924-1770.

## ¡Cuidado con los robos y estafas de EBT!

California ha experimentado un aumento de los robos por Transferencia Electrónica de Beneficios (EBT). Es importante aprender a reconocer estas estafas para evitar que le ocurran a usted.

El Departamento de Servicios Sociales de California ofrece consejos de seguridad a quienes utilizan tarjetas EBT para recibir alimentos (SNAP) y ayudas en efectivo con un breve vídeo en Youtube. Haga clic en este enlace para verlo o escanee el código QR: <u>www.youtube.com/watch?v=O7j7ut0\_FKI</u>

En el vídeo se explica cómo pueden robarse prestaciones de asistencia pública de las tarjetas EBT utilizando:

- Estafas por mensajes de texto y teléfono
- Tecnología de "skimming" de tarjetas
- Sitios web falsos

## Algunos consejos para evitar estafas:

- No haga clic en enlaces de mensajes de texto ni responda mensajes relacionados con EBT. Su condado o el Estado nunca le enviará mensajes de texto ni le llamará para solicitarle sus datos personales, como su número de tarjeta EBT, su numero clave (PIN) o su fecha de nacimiento.
- La "suplantación de número" es cuando los estafadores pueden hacer que su número parezca uno en el que confías, de modo que un mensaje de texto o una llamada telefónica puede parecer que procedan de una fuente legítima. Si no está seguro, póngase en contacto con nosotros directamente.
- Los Skimmers se colocan sobre los cajeros automáticos y los terminales de los comercios para robar o copiar la información de su tarjeta. El vídeo contiene imágenes y consejos para detectar uno.

- Para evitar que pequeñas cámaras secretas graben su PIN, cúbrase siempre la mano cuando lo introduzca.
- Compruebe siempre la URL del sitio web en el que se encuentra. El sitio web oficial de EBT en California es www.ebtproject. ca.gov. Es importante señalar que el sitio real termina en ca.gov. Si ve una URL que termina en otra cosa, es falsa y debe cerrar la página.
- Lo mismo ocurre con las direcciones de correo electrónico falsas. Los correos electrónicos fraudulentos provendrán de una dirección de correo electrónico que no coincide con la que dicen ser.
- No se deje presionar para tomar una decisión rápida. A una persona del gobierno o de una empresa legítima no le importará que tarde en contestarle. En cambio, los estafadores le presionarán para que no tenga tiempo de pensar.



Si cree que sus beneficios pueden haber sido robados, debe llamar inmediatamente al número de teléfono de servicio al cliente que se encuentra en el reverso de su tarjeta EBT: 877-328-9677, o ponte en contácto con los Servicios Sociales del condado de Mono al 760-924-1770.
