- Request a Replacement Card
- Biometrics Access



How to start using the ebtEDGE app on your phone:

Step 1: Search your app store and download the ebtEDGE application, which is represented with this icon.





Open the ebtEDGE Step 2: application and follow the on-screen instructions to register an account.

Select and set three unique Step 3: security questions.

Login by entering your Step 4: User ID and password.
