

Asset Elimination for Medical

Starting in January 2024, assets will no longer count toward your Medi-Cal eligibility. If your coverage was denied, delayed, reduced, or stopped, because of your assets, you can ask your local Medi-Cal office to review your case. Learn more at GetMedi-CalCoverage.dhcs.ca.gov.

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How to Complete Your Medi-Cal Renewal Form





Renewal forms will come in the mail in a bright yellow envelope. You must turn in any information that your local Medi-Cal office needs to renew your Medi-Cal.

Look for the deadline listed on your renewal form. You must respond by that date to keep your Medi-Cal coverage.

Before you get started, make sure you have everything you may need.

- You must provide income information, your address, or details about any changes to who is in your tax-filing household.
- If you have new members in your household or previous household members no longer live with you, you must report the change. Additional verification may be required.
- Some parts of your renewal form are pre-filled based on the information Medi-Cal has on file. Correct or add any new information before submitting. Make corrections even if you've already reported the changes.
- You may need to provide proof of income to confirm you are still eligible. The form lists examples, such as pay stubs, benefits/awards letters, and tax returns.
- You do not need to send proof of non-income assets or property, such as bank accounts, cash, second vehicles and homes, and other financial resources.



Four Ways to Complete Your Medi-Cal Renewal Form:

Choose how you want to renew and complete all the steps

ONLINE

- This is the quickest and easiest way to complete your renewal.
- You can log in or create an account through BenefitsCal.com.
- If you don't know which system to use, visit **KeepMediCalCoverage.org** for help.
- **KeepMediCalCoverage.org** has how-to videos to guide you through completing your form.
- Upload any required proof of regular income, changes to your household, and change of address.

BY PHONE

- You can call your local Medi-Cal office for help or to provide renewal information.
- Call the phone number listed on your renewal form.
- Make sure to have information about your regular income, changes to your household, and change of address ready to share.

BY MAIL

- Follow the instructions on your renewal form.
- Update any information that is wrong or has changed directly on the form.
- Include any required proof of regular income, changes to your household, and change of address with the form.
- Remember to sign and date your form before sending it back.
- Return it in the postage-paid, pre-addressed envelope.

IN PERSON

- You can get help and return your completed form at your local Medi-Cal office.
- If you don't know where to go, visit KeepMediCalCoverage.org and select "Find my local Medi-Cal office."
- Make sure you bring all of your documents with you to update the information that you will be reporting.

Cómo completar su formulario de renovación de Medi-Cal





Los formularios de renovación llegarán por correo en un sobre amarillo. Para renovar su Medi-Cal, tiene que enviar la información que le soliciten a su oficina local de Medi-Cal.

Fíjese en la fecha límite que aparece en su formulario de renovación. Para mantener su cobertura de Medi-Cal, tiene que enviar la información antes de esa fecha.

Antes de comenzar, asegúrese de tener la información que necesita.

- Debe proporcionar información sobre sus ingresos, su dirección o detalles sobre cualquier cambio asociado con las declaraciones de impuesto de las personas que viven en su hogar.
- Si hay nuevos miembros en su hogar o hay miembros de su hogar que ya no viven con usted, debe reportar ese cambio. Puede que haya que hacer verificaciones adicionales.
- Algunas partes de su formulario de renovación ya estarán completadas con la información que Medi-Cal tiene sobre usted. Antes de enviar el formulario, corrija cualquier error o agregue cualquier información nueva. Corrija los errores, aunque ya haya reportado los cambios a la oficina.
- Puede ser que tenga que proporcionar su prueba de ingresos para confirmar que todavía es elegible. El formulario incluye ejemplos como: talones de pago, cartas de notificación de beneficios y declaraciones de impuestos.
- No tiene que enviar pruebas de propiedades ni de bienes que no estén relacionados con sus ingresos, como cuentas de banco, efectivo, un segundo vehículo o una segunda casa, ni ningún otro recurso financiero.

- Incluya cualquier prueba requerida de sus ingresos regulares, cambios en su hogar y cambio de dirección con el formulario.
- Recuerde firmar y fechar su formulario antes de enviarlo
- Envíelo de vuelta en el sobre prepagado con la dirección ya escrita.

Integrated Case Worker I

Employees in this class attend training sessions and work under close supervision to learn regulations, work procedures, forms, and public assistance and/or employment program requirements. Employees are expected to promote to Integrated Case Worker II after one year of satisfactory performance at the entry level.

Integrated Case Worker II

Employees at this level are expected to independently determine eligibility for multiple public assistance programs, provide basic employment services, and perform integrated case management. Positions in this class are flexibly staffed and are normally filled by advancement from the lower level of Integrated Case Worker I, or if filled from the outside, require prior related experience.

Benefits: Mono County provides generous benefits, including CalPERS retirement, medical, dental, vision & 401 deferred compensation. More information on benefits available at monocounty.ca.gov/hr/page/benefits

Example Skills and Duties:

- Interview clients to ascertain employability, isolate barriers to employment, evaluate need for public assistance and determine benefit eligibility.
- Perform case studies to assess problems and develop appropriate types and methods of meeting client needs.
- Analyze financial, employment, family, and personal information to determine and authorize initial or continuing eligibility for multiple aid programs.
- Identify clients with existing or potential social behavioral, mental health, substance abuse, or other substantial barriers to employment for referral to other department staff or community resources.
- Handle crisis situations by authorizing benefits within specific guidelines or make appropriate referrals to other staff and community resources for immediate services and assistance.
- Interpret and explain policies, rules and regulations to clients.
- Use a computer to input client information through an automated system.
- Organize and manage client caseload, taking required action within specific time limits established by regulation and local policy.
- Understand and apply methods and procedures for mitigation/reduction of barriers to employment.
- Communicate clear and accurate information regarding clients, both orally and in writing.
- Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with fellow employees, clients and public.

WERE YOUR FOOD BENEFITS STOLEN AS A RESULT OF ELECTRONIC THEFT?



IF YOUR CALFRESH BENEFITS WERE STOLEN ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2022, YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR RETROACTIVE BENEFIT REPLACEMENTS!

CalFresh recipients who were victims of electronic theft between October 1, 2022 through November 30, 2023 must complete a Report of Electronic Theft Form (EBT 2259) by February 29, 2024 to be eligible to receive retroactive benefit replacements.

CalFresh recipients may be eligible to receive retroactive replacements for any of the following reasons:

- The cardholder did not file an EBT 2259 form,
- An EBT 2259 was previously submitted and denied for not meeting reporting requirements, or
- The cardholder was previously provided with only one month's worth of benefit replacements but had lost more than that amount.
